First and foremost, do not fixate on the patient or the physical world. Once upon a time, a healer found themselves grappling with a difficult situation.

Despite their best efforts, they were unable to help a certain individual in need. Confused and troubled, the healer sought advice from a wise mentor, hoping to understand why their healing abilities had failed them in this instance.

The mentor asked the healer if it was their own power that healed people, or if it was, in fact, a higher force at work. After a moment of introspection, the healer realized that it was a divine source that granted them the ability to heal.

By week's end, they experienced the best week of their life.

A young person in Wisconsin tested this concept by refraining from work altogether and discovered that everything fell into place seamlessly.

Numerous people have realized this truth: when you cease your activities and pray, God's action unfolds, resolving your difficulties and challenges.

However, problems arise when you believe in a power other than God or your own personal strength.

Material existence consists of a series of images, and we are the consciousness of God, the highest aspect of the divine through which thought and action transpire.

When a material being directs their thoughts toward God, the divine force vanquishes evil through their spiritual essence. The material individual cannot achieve anything independently—it is God's action that prevails.

At first, acknowledging that you cannot even pray without God's action may seem daunting, but this realization has benefited countless people.

Each time an individual's mind is not consumed by negativity, sinful thoughts lose their potency and impact. You cannot increase evil, create evil, or cause evil.

By turning your thoughts to God and embracing the truth that humanity is made in the image of God, you allow divine action to work in your life and the lives of those around you.

Realize this by making it real to yourself in contemplation. Then you, the material being [the counterfeit self] "shall have" it, namely, you will be out of your human trouble (2 Corinthians 5:17). You never know the form of

good that you will receive, but you can be certain that the want will disappear.

Point 7: The universe that God created, including His Man, consists of Spiritual ideas in harmonious existence; the unfoldment of good in successive Divine Order (Genesis 1:31). The counterfeit creation, as found in Genesis 2, is a material creation - an illusory world of form, time-and-space, mortality - consists of events that appear to be in sequence. This is a lie. These so-called events are merely 'lines of force' that have always existed, counterfeiting truth with shadow beliefs (Genesis 2:7).

Point 8: These lines of force, or high-tension electrical currents, are nothing but superstition, suppositious claims of "false powers" that appear to be happening in a world of material form (Ephesians 6:12). Point 10: All that is required is to know with sufficient certainty and offer absolute conviction and confidence, that there is only one God, good, and that good can neither cause nor utilize sin, sickness, disease, poverty, lack, disharmony, strife, or any form of evil or wrong-doing, as these are non-reality, and in reality, all is joy, peace, and harmony (Deuteronomy 6:4, Isaiah 41:10)--the trouble(s) would instantly cease.

Point 11: Human thought is redundant and is the resistance that provides the high-tension electrical currents known as "lines of force" their only place of habitation--the human 'no mind' (Isaiah 55:8-9).
