A motion was made and passed for the Lake Association to sponsor Labor Day prizes up to \$700.

Weed Control:

John Varilek reported that weed control this year has been very good. Haveland Beach and the Marina area were reported as been good. Starry Stonewort is way down as are the dead weeds.

Fish Habitat:

John Varilek reported that he will pursue fish stocking again this year and that fishing thus far has been excellent. He reported on significant success in catching notably large crappy this year. Fund raising in support of this year fish stocking will begin

towards the end of July.

Lobdell Lake Rules and Regulations Map

Veronica Pheasant handed out samples of what the 2'x4' maps of Lobdell Lake with Rules and Regulations indicated would look like. She solicited comments on the Maps content and agreed to take the Lake Speed Limit off the Map and add a comment urging safe safe boating practices and proper boating etiquette. Also will add a caution that those born after 12/31/78 will require a Boating Safety Certificate to operate a boat legally. The Map will also mention that the Rules and Regulations apply to Bennett Lake as well.

Four 2'x4' Maps for posting at the public boat launch, the Marina, the Deck Restaurant and North Shore Market will cost \$223.52. A motion was made and passed to fund the purchase of the signs.

Open Discussion:

The police were observed pulling over a wave runner pulling a tuber and forcing the tuber onto the wave runner for lack of a legal observer.
