Sharp sticks	Participants	Area around fires to be checked for dangers	Low	Sticks to be stored in bundles Sticks are not to be played with	Leaders	Sep-24
Uncontrolled fires	All	Buckets of water by each fire	Low	Leaders trained in Fire Safety Areas around fires to be clear of flammable materials Fire to be kept within the Fire Circle	Leaders	Sep-24
Hot surfaces	Participants	Staff to control areas with Hot Surfaces	Low	Participants to be briefed on hazardous hot areas	Leaders	Sep-24
