What could go wrong? <small>What hazard have you identified? What are the risks from it?</small>	Who is at risk?	What are you going to do about it? <small>How are the risks already controlled? What extra controls are needed? How will they be communicated to young people and adults and remain inclusive to all needs?</small>	Review & revise <small>What has changed that needs to be thought about and controlled?</small>
Hazard: Injury from casualty or next of kin. Risk: Physical Assault	First Aid Team	All first aiders have at least First Aid at Work Qualification Seek consent from all parties before proceeding, and if first aider feels that they are at risk then move away. All first aiders have use of radio and are also in contact with support staff. All first aid to be carried out in pairs (or at least with another DBS checked adult present).	
Hazard: Blood Borne Viruses. Infection from contact with blood	First Aid Team	Gloves must always be worn when treating casualty regardless of issue presented. All soiled PPE will be disposed of in bio waste.	
Hazard: Hypothermia	Casualty First aid Team	All staff briefed on awareness, especially zone staff. First Aid Team to be assess clothing required before treatment outside commences.

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Hazard: Injury sustained due to environment	First Aid Team	All first aiders have at least First Aid at Work Qualification First Aider to ensure at all times that it is safe to approach and stay with the casualty.	
Hazard: Treating casualty in tent or areas where adult supervision is minimal Risk: Safeguarding allegation	Casualty	Safeguarding – All treatment to be carried out in pairs or at least with another DBS checked adult present When manned 1 First Aider + 1 Adult present in First Aid building.	
Hazard: Injury from use of Defib in wet conditions Risk: Injury due to incorrect use.	First Aid Team	First Aiders trained in use of Defib and aware of environmental hazards.	
Hazard: Delay in receiving further support from Emergency Services Risk: Escalation of injury/ill health	Casualty	First Aid Team know exact location via Grid Ref, What 3 Words. Briefing with Infrastructure Team to ensure procedure for emergency service access	
Hazard: Administration of child's prescribed medicine Risk: Overdose Incorrect Medicine administered	Child	All medicines marked with child's name, with schedule of administration Medicine prescription checked by another First Aider before administration. Note made of administration on Administration Log	

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Hazard: Administration of generally available medicines i.e Painkillers and Antihistamine Risk: Overdose Anaphalaxis	Child	Contact with parents to advise administration of medicine. Medicine checked by another First Aider before administration. Note made on accident form of date/time of administration
