



DAWID TURNER (30)

CODE NAME: JEREMY

Special Agent DAVID TURNER, the Special Activities Division's most lethal agent. Expert in unarmed combat, hostage extraction, assassination, and survival. Tasked with avenging crimes against the U.S. as the President's "hidden hand," by capturing or killing despots and tyrants, foreign and domestic, from Red Square to Times Square. Bullied in his childhood, Turner likes to beat up bullies in adulthood. Known for his daring and reckless behavior, he was recruited by the CIA after taking down six men in a bar fight. Now he gets to take down the biggest bullies in the world. Trained in the art of self-reliance, he often improvises on the ground during solo assignments. He has nerves of steel and blood pressure that never fluctuates. Most importantly, he was born with a rare genetic defect called congenital analgesia sensory neuropathy in which he is unable to perceive physical pain. Turner has learned to use his "disability" to his advantage as the CIA's top agent.



THE SPECIAL ACTIVITIES DIVISION

When diplomacy fails and war is unwise, the president calls on the CIA's Special Activities Division (SAD), "the tip of the spear." An elite, highly classified branch made up of the agency's top operatives who surprise, kill, and vanish while carrying out covert missions designed for the president to deny and the public to never know.

Many missions, too sensitive for a team, are carried out by a solo SAD operative. That operative is DAVID TURNER.



CONGENITAL ANALGESIA SENSORY NEUROPATHY

A genetic disorder that inhibits the ability to perceive physical pain. There is no known cause, treatment, or cure. It affects fewer than one in a million people.

Turner's inability to feel physical pain makes him sensitive to psychological pain, experiencing severe bouts of depression from the "moral wounds of war." The only place Turner feels pain is in his nightmares where he often relives his missions.



Over the course of the season, Turner will balk at aggressive attempts by the CIA to study his affliction in order to create genetically altered pain-free super spies.

THE GOOD GUYS

AHMAD SHARIF (50)

An Iraqi immigrant and highly decorated former Army Green Beret, Sharif rose through the ranks of the CIA to Station Chief of SAD. Although he deeply cares about his men, his priority is to execute successful missions, whatever the cost.



RAYMOND MORALES (50)

A larger-than-life figure and newly appointed Deputy Director of SAD brought in to end extrajudicial enhanced interrogation (torture) practices. Morales' true intent is to advance unconventional warfare tactics to execute the President's kill list.



JOSEPH ANWAR SALIM (25)

A U.S. Army sniper and CIA agent. Originally from Egypt, he speaks English, Arabic, Farsi, French, and Spanish. Nevertheless, most of his talking is through the barrel of a rifle, regularly providing back up for Turner, until he is captured himself...







FRANK LUCIANO (25)

A Marine platoon leader rescued by Turner. Luciano suffers survivor's guilt thinking he let his men down during an ambush. The Silver Star Medal he's awarded doesn't help, leading to suicidal thoughts. Turner will try to help.



THE TRIP TO BABYLON

While posing as a tourist in Iraq, an elite CIA operative on the hunt for a top Al-Qaeda leader and a U.S. Marine held hostage, proves to be a tough nut to crack when captured and tortured because of a genetic disorder in which he feels no pain.



ACT I

Happy-go-lucky American tourist, JEREMY, travels to Babylon with his new friend, ZAFAR. They meet a friendly Bedouin along the way, but soon thereafter we realize that not everyone is who they seem to be. Zafar betrays Jeremy, allowing him to be kidnapped in exchange for cash. He is dragged into a bunker where a U.S. Marine, LT. FRANK LUCIANO, is held captive.

ACT II

Zafar is assassinated by the Bedouin they met earlier. Al-Qaeda leader, ALI AL-MAJID, accuses Jeremy of being a spy, waterboarding him to force a confession. Meanwhile, CIA Station Chief AHMAD SHARIF briefs Deputy Director RAYMOND MORALES on Al-Majid and the Marine hostage. Sharif tells Morales that his top man, Special Agent David Turner, is moving in.

ACT III

Jeremy succumbs to the torture, admitting he's CIA. In disbelief that a CIA agent would crack so easily, Al-Majid now thinks Jeremy is a tourist and orders his men to kill him. But once Jeremy's restraints are cut, he grabs his first victim by the throat. Jeremy is Special Agent DAVID TURNER. Turner engages in expert hand-to-hand combat and vicious knife-fighting, killing Al-Majid. Meanwhile, Sharif briefs Morales on Turner's rare condition that makes him immune to pain!

ACT IV

The mysterious Bedouin aka Agent JOSEPH ANWAR SALIM, U.S. Army Sniper, fires from the foothills, taking out Al-Majid's men as Turner and Luciano fight their way out of the bunker. Turner activates a GPS transmitter alerting Sharif to give the order to "Target Jeremy." Chinooks scoop up the agents and return them to a CIA aircraft carrier where Turner receives a congratulatory phone call from the President.

ACT V

Turner watches a news report leaking his recent mission followed by another story about Afghan interpreters set for execution in Kabul's most notorious prison. Turner gets a call from Sharif with his new mission.

EPISODES

1. LOVE HURTS

Turner rekindles romance with a former flame, an Afghan journalist, while freeing captive Afghan interpreters.

2. HAZY DOES IT

American diplomats are incapacitated by strange neuro-wave warfare in Cuba. Turner must find and neutralize the source.

3. FIGHT CLUB

Turner becomes a cage fighter to infiltrate a white nationalist militia plotting to blow up D.C. monuments.

4. IN THE SOUP

Turner joins a Pacific Ocean voyage to stop a mad sea captain on an illegal fishing trawler netting sharks for their fins.

5. TEACHING MOMENT

Turner squares off, mano-a-mano, against a diabolically rogue and murderous Navy SEAL Team captain who was his mentor.

6. APE SHIT

Turner tracks down ruthless exotic wild game trophy hunters on the hunt for a silverback gorilla in the Congo rainforest.

7. AT SEA

Turner rescues over 3,000 passengers and crew held hostage by 50 hijackers on the world's largest ocean cruise liner.

8. ANIMAL HOUSE

Turner goes undercover at West Point to nail the culprits of 3 fraternity hazing murders, getting hazed in the process.

9. SURFIN' USA

Turner hits the waves to catch the ringleader behind arms dealing surfers doing business with human traffickers.

10. ESCAPISM

Turner pursues his former boss, a criminally indicted expresident, who faked his assassination and fled the country.
