Private Instruction

Private Lessons – \$75 / 1 hr

Private Handgun Permit – \$225 / 6 hr Enhanced Private or \$125 / 2 hr Concealed Private

This option is ideal for beginners, busy professionals, or anyone who wants a private, supportive environment while gaining the knowledge and confidence to carry legally and responsibly.

Handgun Courses

Tennessee Enhanced Handgun Carry Permit Certification – \$59 / 6-8 hrs

- State-mandated course to obtain Tennessee Enhanced Handgun Carry Permit
- Students must **pre-register** with the state via [TN.gov](https://www.tn.gov).
- **Required Equipment:** A handgun, 50 rounds of ammunition, ID, safety gear, and appropriate clothing. Handguns and ammo are available for rent or purchase at the range

Tennessee Concealed-Only Handgun Carry Permit Certification – \$45 / 2 hrs

- State-approved course to obtain Tennessee Concealed Handgun Carry Permit
- Most providers offer Conceal Only training online only/no qualification
We provide live, in-person instruction
- Designed for students with trauma concerns, physical limitations, or who prefer guided support

Women-Only Handgun Fundamentals – \$60 / 4 hrs

- This course is designed for new and developing shooters who want a strong foundation in safe handgun handling and basic marksmanship. Students (women ages 18+) will learn the essential skills needed to confidently and responsibly operate a handgun in a controlled range environment.
- **Equipment:** Students may bring their own handgun, or rentals are available. There is no ammo minimum, nor are students required to shoot. Eye and ear protection required on the firing range (available on site).

Intro to Competition Shooting – \$129 / 4 hrs

- Whether you're curious about local matches or looking to take your range skills to the next level, this course is the perfect starting point.
- In this course, you'll learn the basics of popular competition formats (USPSA, IDPA, Steel Challenge, etc.), how to safely navigate a course of fire, gear selection and setup tips, stage strategy, scoring, and match etiquette, live-fire drills that simulate real match scenarios.
- **Required Equipment:** A reliable handgun, holster, magazines, eye and ear protection, and 150–200 rounds of ammunition.

Rifle Courses

AR Rifle (Level I) Foundations – \$129 / 4 hrs

- Provides a structured introduction to the safe operation of the AR-style rifle using classroom instruction, dry-fire practice, and controlled live-fire exercises. Topics include rifle components and function, safe handling, basic maintenance, marksmanship fundamentals, ready positions, introductory sling use, zero confirmation, and administrative reload concepts.
- **Required Equipment:** AR-style rifle, magazines, cleaning kit, eye and ear protection, 100 rounds of ammunition, and weather-appropriate attire.

AR Rifle (Level II) Applied Movement & Positioning – \$129 / 4 hrs

- This course advances AR-style rifle skills through applied shooting fundamentals. Training includes shooting on the move (forward, lateral, and diagonal), use of cover and concealment, positional transitions, target discrimination and engagement order, and managing reloads and malfunctions while moving during controlled live-fire exercises.
- **Prerequisite:** AR Rifle Basics (Level I) or equivalent training.
Required Equipment: AR-style rifle, minimum 3 magazines, sling, eye and ear protection, 200 rounds of ammunition, weather-appropriate attire.

Tactical Operations / Basic SWAT – \$495 / 40+ hrs – DEPARTMENT APPROVAL REQUIRED –

- This course provides essential tactical training for Law Enforcement personnel assigned to Special Operations, Narcotics, Warrants, and Patrol units seeking to strengthen operational skills. Instruction focuses on movement mechanics, tactical decision-making, and hands-on team-based exercises in dynamic training environments. Designed for officers responsible for planning and executing elevated-threat responses, topics include team roles, risk assessment and operational planning, live-fire weapons skills, contact and cover, room clearing, movement, and structure response (residential, commercial, school).
- **Required Equipment:** Tactical uniform (BDUs), web gear, holster, flashlight, duty gear, ballistic vest, helmet (if issued), eye/ear protection, gloves, weather-appropriate clothing, handgun with 3 magazines and 350 rounds of ammo, notebook and pen, water, and protein snacks.

Tactical Operations / Advanced SWAT – \$525 / 40+ hrs – DEPARTMENT APPROVAL REQUIRED –

- This high-intensity course focuses on movement mechanics, tactical decision-making, and advanced team operations. Training includes live fire, simulations, night movement, vehicle and bus assaults, rapid entry, CQB, AP2, rescue techniques, and tactical equipment use. Students train hands-on in dynamic scenarios requiring coordinated team performance. Topics include team roles, risk assessment and operational planning, handgun and rifle skills, active protection, deployment, and assault operations.
- **Prerequisite:** Prior Basic Tactical Operations/SWAT training
- **Required Equipment:** BDU-style tactical attire, web gear, holster, flashlight, duty gear, ballistic vest, helmet (if issued), eye/ear protection, mouth guard, groin protection, gloves, weather-appropriate clothing, handgun (3 mags, 300 rounds), tactical rifle (3 mags, 250 rounds), notebook, water, and protein snacks.
- Training equipment, targets, and strike pads provided by Norsemen.

Community Courses

Church Security – By appointment only

- Prepare your church security team to protect and respond with confidence. This custom to your organizational needs course blends situational awareness, defensive tactics, verbal de-escalation, and legal considerations specific to faith-based settings. Training includes live-fire drills, threat identification, active shooter response, and communication protocols to safeguard congregants while maintaining a welcoming environment.

Youth Foundational Safety (Ages 12+) – \$75 / 2 hrs (classroom, range time, rental & ammo included)

- Youth need safe, supervised instruction whenever they might encounter firearms—at home, with family, or in recreational shooting. Our course teaches responsible handling, basic marksmanship, and range safety in a controlled, supportive environment. Build confidence, focus, and lifelong safety habits. This can be taught as a single student session or a group training.
- **Equipment:** The course includes a rental .22 LR firearm and ammunition provided. Students are not required to shoot. Eye and ear protection is required on the firing range and is available on site.
- **Parent Information:** Parents are not required to stay for the session, but must sign a range waiver prior to youth participation.

Certification Courses

NRA Range Safety Officer Certification – \$129 / 9 hrs • Min 4 students

- This official NRA course prepares responsible gun owners, range staff, and instructors to safely oversee shooting range operations. Students will learn essential duties of an RSO, including conducting range inspections, enforcing range rules, handling malfunctions and stoppages, and ensuring overall safety during live-fire events. Emphasis is placed on communication, emergency response, and range commands. **Required Equipment:** N/A

NRA Basics of Pistol Shooting Certification – \$175 / 8 hrs • Min 4 students

- Designed for individuals of all experience levels, regardless of prior shooting experience or NRA membership. The curriculum covers gun safety, proper firearm operation, ammunition, storage, shooting fundamentals, maintenance, marksmanship, and range safety. Students will complete a Basics of Pistol Shooting Student Examination, participate in live-fire training, and undergo a nationally standardized shooting qualification on the range under the guidance of an NRA Certified Instructor.
- **Required Equipment:** A handgun, 50 rounds of ammunition, ID, safety gear, and appropriate clothing. Handguns and ammo are available for rent or purchase at the range.

TN Armed Guard Certification – \$160 / \$75 renewal • 16 hrs / 4 hrs • Min 4 students

- All candidates must be at least 21 years old and complete the following:
 - 4-Hour Basics Course
 - 8-Hour Classroom Course
 - 4 Hours of Marksmanship
- Does not include Dallas Law requirements (if applicable).
- **Required Equipment:** Students may bring their own handgun, or rentals are available, 50 rounds of ammunition per firearm, eye and ear protection required (available on site).

Renewal: A 4-hour refresher course including a qualification is required for ongoing certification

TN Un-Armed Guard Certification – \$75 / \$50 renewal • 4 hrs / 2 hrs

- All candidates must meet the minimum age requirement of 18 and complete a 4-hour Basic Course plus an examination covering required subjects. The Basic Course includes one (1) hour each of:
 - Orientation
 - Legal Powers & Limitations of a Security Guard/Officer
 - Emergency Procedures
 - General Duties
- Renewal: A 2-hour refresher course is required for ongoing certification.
