ENTERTAINMENT & SPECIAL EVENTS: Comrade Rayfield

Since the decision made at the General Meeting on 30 November, 2021, relating to the DANCE FLOOR REPLACEMENT and ENLARGEMENT in the Juno Lounge, I have received two of three quotes for the cost of this much needed and overdue project.

- After adding extra tables for the New Years Eve Gala Dinner and Dance because of demand, I'm pleased to report that we were sold out as of December 7. In comparison to 2019 when we sold only 80 tickets with more than \$400 spent on advertising, this year we have sold 202 tickets without a single dime being spent on advertising. I will add that roughly 70 tickets have been sold to members of two different Singles Clubs that were downplayed by Comrade Holmes at the November General Meeting.
- I have begun to contact several booking agents to line up entertainers for future dinner shows. I have confirmed a booking for Sunday, March 13, 2022. The artist will be presenting his Voices of Legends Show, impersonations of several famous singers & groups, highlighting Garth Brooks.
- The Grey Cup Party held on Sunday, December 12, proved to be quite successful with 38 people in attendance, including 17 members of the Professional Singles Club.
- The two singles clubs that I repeatedly draw upon, have become loyal supporters of the Kingsway Legion, not only at our weekend dances and our special events, but also booking our facility for several different types of functions on an ongoing basis.
