

KINGSWAY LEGION HOUSE RULES

- 1. Members and staff must comply with the Liquor Laws of the Province of Alberta.
- 2. Members are permitted to sign in guests but must remain with said guests and be responsible while in the branch.
- 3. Profane language or unseemly conduct will not be tolerated under any circumstances.
- 4. The Sgt at Arms is responsible for the enforcement of the House Rules.
- 5. Neat, clean and casual dress is acceptable at all times.
- 6. DRESS RULES:
 - a. Members or guests wearing dirty/and or torn clothing are NOT admitted within the premises at ANYTIME
 - b. The following articles of clothing will NOT be worn in the Branch at any time:
 - i. Undershirts as an outer garment.
 - ii. Muscle Shirts, tank tops or sleeveless T-shirts
 - iii. Sports Shorts eg. Spandex, etc.
 - iv. Work Coveralls and Dirty Construction Style Footwear.
 - c. On November 11th, Remembrance Day and Battle Honour celebrations days, there will be no Sweat Pants, or Shorts of any kind allowed in the Branch.
 - d. Members and guests shall remove headdress while in the Legion, except for special functions/medial reasons. Members are allowed to wear uniform berets in the Branch when appropriate.
 - e. All Members and Guests MUST wear shoes at all times.
 - f. Shorts are allowed if they are of a decent length.
 - g. All Armed Services uniforms are acceptable at any time pursuant to Military Dress Code.
- 7. Notwithstanding the foregoing regulations, the SGT at Arms and members of the Legion Executive may refuse admission and service to any person, should they deem it advisable in the interest of the Branch.
- 8. Members of the Executive or Members at large DO NOT have supervisory or command privileges to direct staff in any form. All staff remains the responsibility of the Branch Manager. Should you have queries regarding staff direct them to the Manager DO NOT facilitate action on your own.
- 9. Membership cards must be produced upon request of the SGT @ Arms or any authorized legion member.

PLEASE DO NOT EMBARRASS YOUR GUEST BY ATTEMPTING TO GAIN ADMITANCE WHEN THEIR DEPORTMENT OR DRESS CONTRAVENE THE ABOVE REGULATION.
