I will move or cause to be moved the following amendments to the Kingsway Branch 175 Bylaws.

As it reads now:

Page 4 Article VI Section 6.4(b) The Returning Officers shall endure the ballot box is always locked and sealed and remains so until voting on General Election days as provided in Section 6.01 of this By-Laws is concluded.

To delete in its entirety.

Page 5 Article VII Section 7.1(a) When due to the lack of a quorum at any General Meeting, proposals for the expenditures of monies for the benefit of the Branch cannot be dealt with and approved by the /General Membership at the next properly constituted General Meeting.

To delete in its entirety

Page 9 Article XII Section 12.1 All officers, members, and staff who handle Branch funds shall be covered by a blanket bond, except those persons with financial authority, shall be individually bonded for the amount not less than \$100,000.00. The cost of bonding shall be borne by the Branch. No two (2) family members (which includes Common Law spouse) shall have signing authority.

Change to read: All officers, members and staff who handle Branch funds shall be covered by a blanket bond, except those persons with financial authority, shall be individually bonded for the amount not less than \$100,000.00. The cost of bonding shall be borne by the Branch.

Delete the sentence: No two (2) family members (which includes Common Law spouse) shall have signing authority.

Page 9 Article XII Section 12.2 c reads: To attain eligible delegate status, a member must have attended four (4) General and/or Executive Meetings and one each of District 2 and Area B rallies in the calendar year immediately prior to the Convention call and be a member in good standing.

Change to read: To attain eligible delegate status, a member must have attended four (4) General and/or Executive Meetings and one of District 2 or Area B rallies in the calendar year immediately prior to the Convention call and be a Member in good standing.

Reason behind the changes:

Section 6.4 (a)

Moving to delete this paragraph as we do not have ballot boxes anymore since we now do our elections at our General Meeting in November.

Section 7.1 (a) Our quorum is "those members present in good standing" so this paragraph is not needed.

Section 12.1 Delete the last sentence because it is already written in the Article X Section 10.7 on page 7.

Section 12.2 (c) we now only have one Area B rally so if a member is unable to attend the spring rally, then they are not eligible to be a delegate at Convention.
