A Talk with the Padre

A note from your Padre, June /July 2023

Lost Treasures “Part Two” June/July 2023

Welcome back to our second edition of Lost Treasures.

We left off last month, considering the back story to the real lesson Jesus is teaching in the passage of Scripture, and briefly considered the story of “The Lost Sheep.”

Story #2, Luke 15:8-10

Or suppose a woman has ten silver coins^[a] and loses one. Doesn't she light a lamp, sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it? And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost coin.' In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.”

As we read this, we may be tempted to say, “come on, its only a lost coin, a Tonnie maybe?” What is the big deal here? No, these were valuable coins. This woman has lost a considerable amount of money, its like losing a section of your investment portfolio. There were no banks to keep your valuables safe back then. Your monetary investments were kept at home. Its like losing the stone on your engagement ring, and so you begin to scour the house for it. You sweep every inch of the house; you move every piece of furniture until you find it. And, when you find it, you party. You celebrate by calling your friends and neighbours and say, lets party because the investment I thought was lost forever has been found. When something is lost you search intently until you find it. If you lose the stone on your ring, you don't give it ten minutes and then say, “oh well.” And the audience at the time when Jesus told this story totally agrees, this is what you do. But, before anyone can ask a question, Jesus launches into the third and most powerful of the three stories, and this one will hit home to the audience He was talking to.

We pick up Jesus' story in Luke 15:19-52. It is too long to record here, so I encourage you to read it on your own. But the first several verses really tell much of the story, and it is good for us to remember that Jesus here is referring to the Father, His Father in Heaven who pursues us until He finds us.

To illustrate the point further, Jesus told them this story: “A man had two sons. The younger son told his father, 'I want my share of your estate now before you die.' So, his father agreed to divide his wealth between his sons.

“A few days later this younger son packed all his belongings and moved to a distant land, and there he wasted all his money in wild living. About the time his money ran out, a great famine swept over the land, and he began to starve. He persuaded a local farmer to hire him, and the man sent him into his fields to feed the pigs. The young man became so hungry that even the pods he was feeding the pigs looked good to him. But no one gave him anything.

“When he finally came to his senses, he said to himself, 'At home even the hired servants have food enough to spare, and here I am dying of hunger! I will go home to my father and say, "Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son. Please take me on as a hired servant.'”

“So, he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him. His son said to him, ‘Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son.

Did you catch this truth, “**the Father first of all saw his son, and then ran to him, embraced him, kissed him, and forgave him.**” When the son asked for his part of the inheritance, what he was in essence wanting was for his father to be dead, and while in today’s culture this would be unacceptable, in that culture the father was required to kick his son out of the house with nothing. But remember this father is filled with love for his son, and so he gives in to his request. But even that is not the real story here. The real story here is when the son returns, broken, broke, hungry, stinking like a pig, his father runs toward him. Those listening to this story, the leaders of the day would have been horrified. Imagine the father touching his son, who had belittled him, and gone to work on a pig farm. Remember this was a Jewish audience, and nothing was dirtier than a pig, and this boy sat in the pig pen.

This is not simply a story of a forgiving loving earthly father, this is a story of **the living, Loving, Gracious heavenly Fathers, who waits for us with open arms to forgive and accept us, even when we reject Him. Like** this son who disrespected his father, who wanted him dead, we so often reject God who gave us His Son to die in our place. But our Heavenly Father, stands with open arms to receive us, no matter where we have been, no matter what we may have done, no matter how bad we think we are. Friends, none of us is beyond our Heavenly Father’s reach and He stands ready to receive us, and make us His children. The point of the story was that this was as bad as it could get for the son, and yet the father not only embrace him, but was looking for him, and kissed him. That was an earthly father, but imagine this:

A couple of months ago, I parked on this passage, and I want to do so again today.

John 3:16, “for God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, (Jesus) that whoever believes on Him, would not perish but have eternal life.”

Like this “prodigal son,” was accepted back into the family, so we can be accepted into God’s family, but receiving the forgiveness that Jesus offers us. This son was a lost treasure, the most valuable one could consider, but he was found when the father ran towards him and accepted him back into his family.

I trust you will have a great summer enjoying some good weather, and times with family and friends. I know we plan to, but first attending a Family (my wife’s side) retreat in Manitoba, and then a wedding in the mountains, along with a visit from our son, who lives in Ottawa.

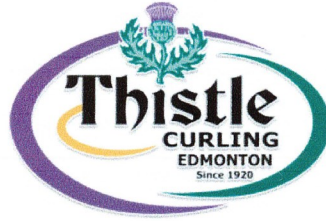

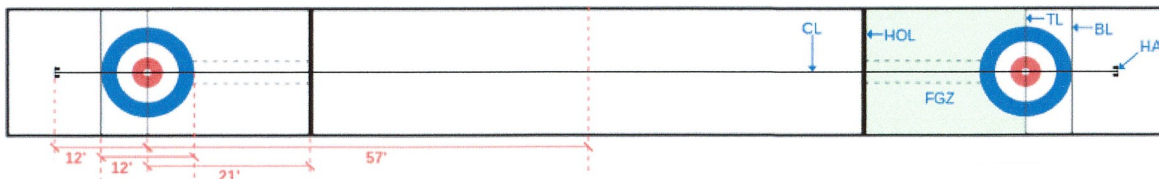
