From AB/NWT Command

Below are excerpts taken from an email sent to the Branches from Command on 18 Feb 21

As you are aware, Dominion Executive Council (DEC) approved the rescheduling of the 2020 Dominion Convention from this August to 12-19 August 2021 in Saskatoon.

As a result, the 2022 Dominion Convention scheduled for 20-25 August 2022 in Saint John, NB is also rescheduled, to August 2024.

There are still so many unknowns with this virus, making it difficult to know how to proceed, but the health of our Members and communities is the most important factor.

We must do everything possible to protect the health of others.

It is with this in mind, that the Sub Executive Committee has decided to **CANCEL the 2021 Spring Rallies and Elections of DDCs.** This will extend the term of the DDCs to 42 months.

It is our hope that Rallies will go forward in the fall of 2021, where elections for DDCs will be held. The newly elected DDCs term will be 30 months.

If we all continue on this path of vigilance, we will have the close comradeship we have come to expect and hold so dear.


