

A Talk with the Padre

“Laughter” “Meet the Jesus I know.”

Hi Comrades:

I want to begin this article by saying that as you read it, you may start to think, “Hey, didn’t the Padre write something about Laughing, sometime near the beginning of last year?” If you’re thinking that you would be right. I have thought much about lacking the fun factor in my life, far too often, and taking life to seriously. I realize we are all about something, but it seems laughter comes to infrequently, so bear with me as I pontificate further on the matter. I am also quick to add that some of my material comes from the Book, “He gets us,” written by one of my favourite authors, Max Lucado.

I have been a follower of Jesus for many years, and there were times in my life, and unfortunately still are, when I think that “Christians,” don’t seem to have a whole lot of fun. But then I realize that the Jesus I follow, was someone who wasn’t just a serious person who, demanded that when we choose to follow Him, a seriousness and a solemn life style. Not at all, So please stay with me and allow me to show you a Jesus who was filled with joy, laughter and was fun loving.

Jesus was no stranger to joy. He went to weddings; He shared lively meals with His friends. He drank with them. He had so much fun with His followers, and acted freely around the dinner table, that the uptight **religious** leaders called Him a glutton and a drunkard. (Matthew 11:19) **The Son of man came eating and drinking and they say, “look. A glutton and a drunkard, a friend of sinners!”**

Jesus did not worry about what would happen to His reputation when He hung out with people who others thought were shady, and He was uninhibited in His pursuit of compassion and joy for others. While I have not seen this picture personally the writer, I referred to earlier Max Lucado has on the wall across from his desk a picture given to him by a priest of Jesus Laughing. I wish I could see that picture, but he describes it as Jesus with His head back, His mouth open, His eyes sparkling, not just grinning, or chuckling but roaring with Laughter, like He hasn’t seen or heard anything quite like that in a long time.

You see Comrades, Jesus despite what the future held for Him, when He died on the Cross so that you and I could be forgiven and spend eternity with Him, wants the same for us. Consider Jesus attending a wedding to which He was invited, in John 2, where it tells us: “Jesus and His followers were invited to the wedding.” Let me put it this way, when the bride and groom put the guest list together, may well have said something like this, “when you put the guest list together, make sure Jesus and His followers are on the list.”

Why am I saying this, well I look at it this way, if I am having a party to which I am inviting others, I try to make sure that at least some of the people I am inviting, are people who are going to lighten up the event and provide some fun moments for all the guest to enjoy.

A Talk with the Padre

Jesus wasn't invited because He was a celebrity. He wasn't one yet. The invitation wasn't motivated by His miracles. He'd yet to perform any. Why did they invite Him? I believe He was invited because the common folks in this little town enjoyed being with Jesus.

I am confident that the **"Holy One,"** wasn't holier-than-thou, the **"One who knew it all,"** wasn't a know – it – all, the **"The One who knew it all,"** wasn't a know – it – all. **"The One who made the stars,"** didn't keep His head in them.

Jesus' purpose was not to show off but to show up. He went to great pains to be as human as you and I who may have lived down the street. Jesus didn't need to study, but He still went to the synagogue. Jesus had known the fellowship of angels, and had heard the sweet music of heaven, and yet he went to parties thrown by "tax collectors."

Upon the shoulders of Jesus rested the ultimate challenge of bringing salvation and redemption to His creation, to you and me, and yet He took the time to walk for miles to attend a wedding in Cana. And as a result, people liked Him. Someone made this claim about Jesus, **"people who were very much unlike Him, liked Him."** He was branded a radical but never accused of being unapproachable. There is never a hint of Jesus using His heavenly status for personal gain, ever.

His faith made Him likable, Jesus was accused of much, all unjustified, but He was never accused of being a sourpuss, or self-centered. No, people didn't groan when He walked into a room. He called them by name, He listened to their stories, He answered their questions. He visited their relatives, and helped their sick friends. He fished with fishermen and ate lunch with the little guy, and spoke resounding words of affirmation to them.

People were drawn to Jesus; He was always on the "guest list." Thousands came to hear Him, and Hundreds chose to follow Him. They shut down their businesses and walked away from careers to be with Him, and His purpose statement read like this: **"I came to give life with joy and Abundance."** John 10:10.

When the Angels announced the arrival of Jesus the Messiah, they proclaimed "good news of great joy" Luke 2:10, not "bad news.

So, let me ask, you and me, "what kind of a portrait of Jesus hangs on the walls of my mind? My prayer is that the Jesus I know, the Jesus who laughed and was full of joy, that this Jesus will become the Joy Giver in your lives. The Jesus I know, is the one whose greatest desire is for each of us to have a personal relationship with Him. The Jesus I know, stands ready to forgive us our sins, and invites us to accept His gift of life. Jesus came to be the "Life of the party," and He came to give us joy, peace and eternal life.

So, I invite each of you, to **"meet the Jesus I know."**




