A Talk with the Padre

A note from your Padre, January 2025

First and foremost, comrades, I extend to each of you a Happy and Blessed New Year. My prayer is that you will a sense of peace and comfort in each of your lives as we walk through 2025. I continue to say thank you for allowing me to serve you as your Padre for another term, although like I said to our new president Comrade Rick, if he has anyone waiting in the wings, changes could be made.

I don't know about you, but a new year brings with it the opportunity to make changes that we either need to, or wish to make. For me the opportunity in 2025 is to experience a deeper sense of contentment and inner peace, and while I tend to be quite content with where life is for me personally as I age it seems that sleep and rest come more easily and with that comes a deeper sense of contentment.

Many of us prepare for the new year by making some New Years Resolutions, and we are far enough into the new year to have experienced the making and failing of resolutions. But what if the way many seek to accomplish New Year's resolutions is flawed? Just saying!

One of the most popular New Years Resolutions is: a new desire to become more active and get into a better physical shape. Gyms see a marked increase in memberships in January, and that is a good thing. But alas something happens and that resolution falls by the way side. I know the gym I go to (and no that is not a new year's resolution, I have done it regularly for years) seems to have a number of new faces after the new year. Here is an interesting statistic. While nearly 50% of us make New Years Resolutions, on about 25% of us actually stay committed after just 30 days, and that according to a Columbia University study, and only about 10% of people carry them through to the end of the year. Enough of the negative statistics.

You might ask the question why is that statistic so low? I am glad you asked. I have a confession: I've never been one to like rules. While I know they're necessary for an orderly and safe life, both in society and as an individual, I often felt that rules restricted rather than liberated me while growing up. As you know I was an RCMP Officer for some 24 years and enforced the rules (laws) that our political masters created, and for the most part they are intended as the well being of society, but there were internal rules, policies that seemed to make little or no sense for the Cop on the street.

For others, rules tend to provide a sense of safety and certainty. But everyone has a rule that governs how they live. Whether explicitly communicated or not, each person, family, or community has certain habits that determine their way of being in the world. We might just call that the "Rules of Life."

One of the ways we can develop "rules for life," in lieu of resolutions which many of us are not able to keep, is to examine in a new and fresh way, "How does a Loving God factor into our everyday lives?"

Rule of Life Over Resolutions

I have another confession: I have not yet made any New Year's resolutions, and I don't plan to. I have nothing against resolutions, but I do think our current strategy of employing them is broken.

Author and pastor Rich Villodas put it this way: "Resolutions are good, but a Rule of Life is better. Resolutions are often about goals that require lots of willpower. A Rule for life is about submitting to a God who has our best interests at heart, which in turn will reorder our hearts and form our wills. Resolutions often focus on what we want or need to do (which, again, is good and necessary), but a rule of life focuses on the type of person we want to become. In essence, these rules help us to rightly order our *being* before our *doing* so that all of our life's activity flows from a deep rootedness in the love that God our Creator has for us."

So, maybe a fair question might well be, "What is my security and well being anchored to? Finances, family, friends? While all important in our lives, I like what the song writer, Donna Sommers sings, "My Anchor Holds." What he is saying, and I agree with him that our anchor for life needs to be on the person of our loving Creator God. His love for us is truly shown in this passage of scripture that I have reference before.

John 3: 16-17

For God so loved the world (that includes you and me) that He gave His Only Son (Jesus, whose birth we just celebrated this past Christmas) that whosoever (that included you and me) believes in Him, will not perish but have everlasting life. (life in God's Heaven for ever)

So, as I wrap this up, and ask this question to each of us reading this. What helps your state of well being? With God as our guide, and helping us with the "Rules for Life," and understanding that His love for us is something we can all take to the bank, I pray a prayer of Blessing over each of your lives. May each of us this new year experience the peace of Jesus, our "Anchor" over your lives. In the Name of The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.


