

PARKING PLAN - version 23.07.11

Ian Tyson Memorial Music Festival – July 30, 2023

PARKING LOTS

Lot #1: We will be directing attendees to self-park at the Park and Ride near the bridge on Centre St W with a shuttle bus leaving at scheduled intervals to be posted.

Lot #2: We have been given permission by Shane Koop to utilize the site of the former Koop's Automotive site at 309 Government Rd will have lot attendants and a shuttle bus to the festival site leaving at scheduled intervals.

Lot #3: We have spoken with Oilfields High School and will direct festival goers to use the OHS parking lots including the Curling Rink parking lots near the Pump Track and Skate Park.

Lot #4: We have been granted permission to use the Mountain View Developments lot at 129 Willow Ridge Blvd SW as our main parking lot, and will provide parking lot attendants and a festival shuttle bus transporting attendees to the festival site.

Additional Shuttle Transport: We will have a shuttle bus leaving the Sheep River Library/Flare and Derrick parking lot in Turner Valley at scheduled intervals

- *" Festival Parking" signs will be placed, within Black Diamond, as per the Blue Dots on the attached map
- *" Festival Parking & Shuttle" signs will be placed on the roadside at the Flare and Derrick, Koop's Lot, Park and Ride, and Mountain View Developments Lot with Shuttle schedule
- *Parking lot maps & Shuttle schedules will be posted on the Chamber website and on our Chamber & Festival social media PARKING LOT ATTENDANTS – onsite at each lot from 1130 to 2330 / 4 x 3hr shifts

Lot #1: Park & Ride on Centre St West by bridge to TV: Self-parking

Lot #2: Koop's Lot at 309 Government Rd: One pair of parking attendants directing traffic flow and parking coordination

Lot #3: Oilfields High School / Curling Rink: Two pairs of parking attendants directing traffic flow

Lot #4: Mountain West Developments Lot at 129 Willow Ridge Blvd SW: Three pairs of parking attendants directing traffic flow and parking coordination

EASE OF ACCESS

<u>We will be ensuring</u> that there is a reserved spot in front of both festival gates for pick-up and drop-off and to ensure that seniors and attendees with physical disabilities, as well as emergency response vehicles, have ease of access to the festival NOTIFICATIONS

We will be papering the residents' homes within a two-block radius of the event with festival details, Chamber contact information, the potential for parking conflicts, and recommending that they reserve the spot in front of their home with a pylon, or similar structure, to ensure that their parking is not taken by festival attendees on the day.
