No shade cover – limits play during hottest times

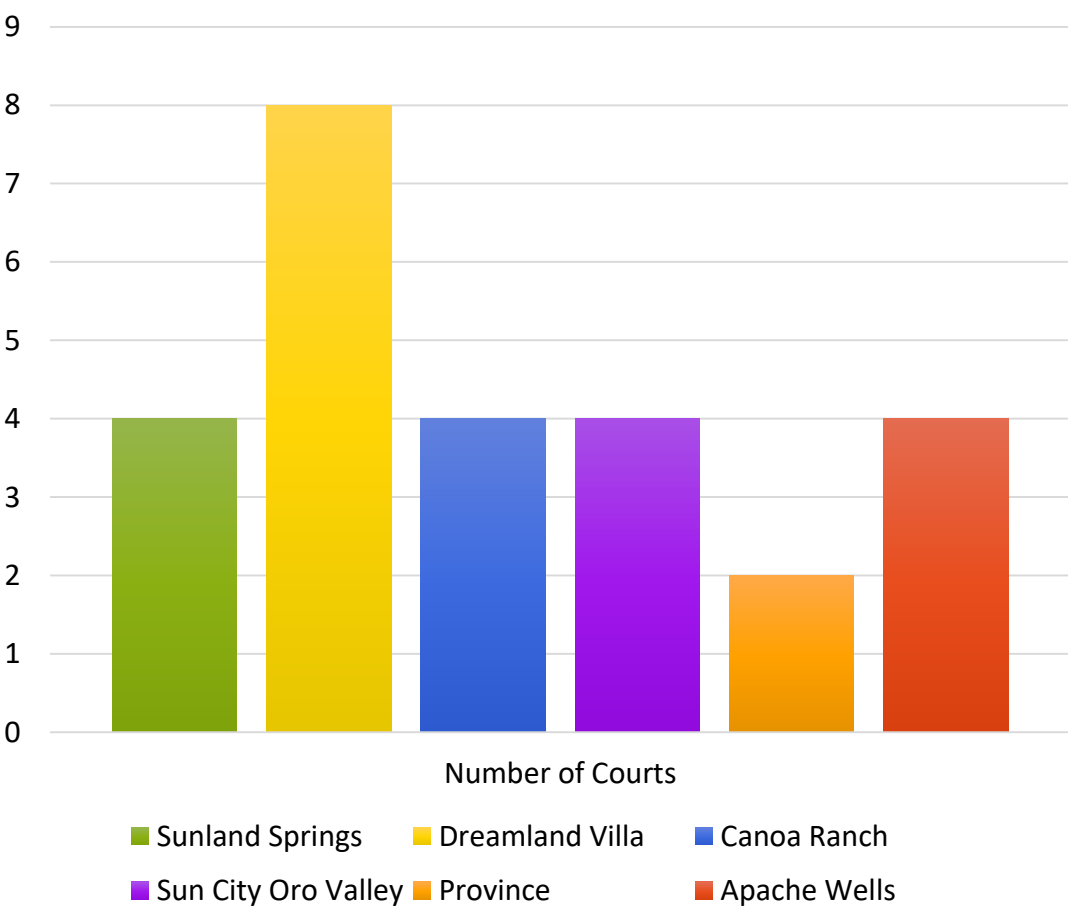
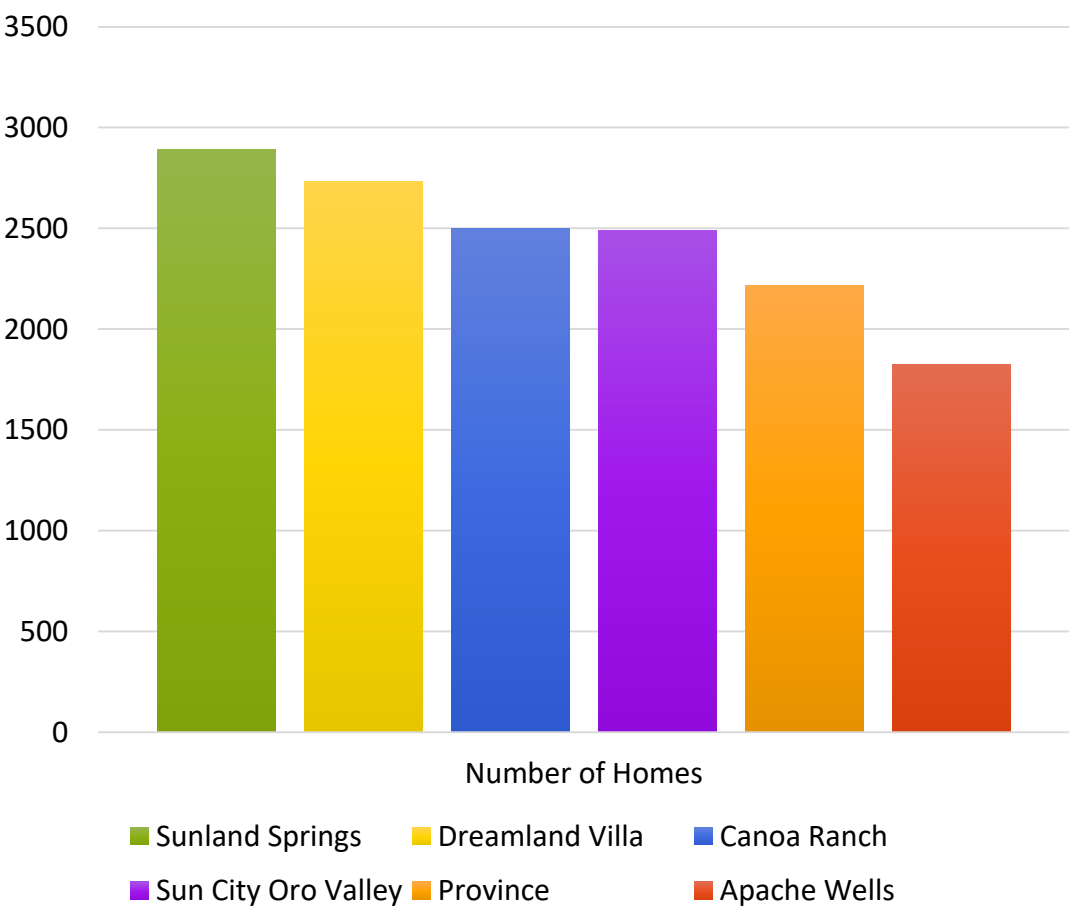
Rocks difficult to walk on –

Rocks get on court and damage balls



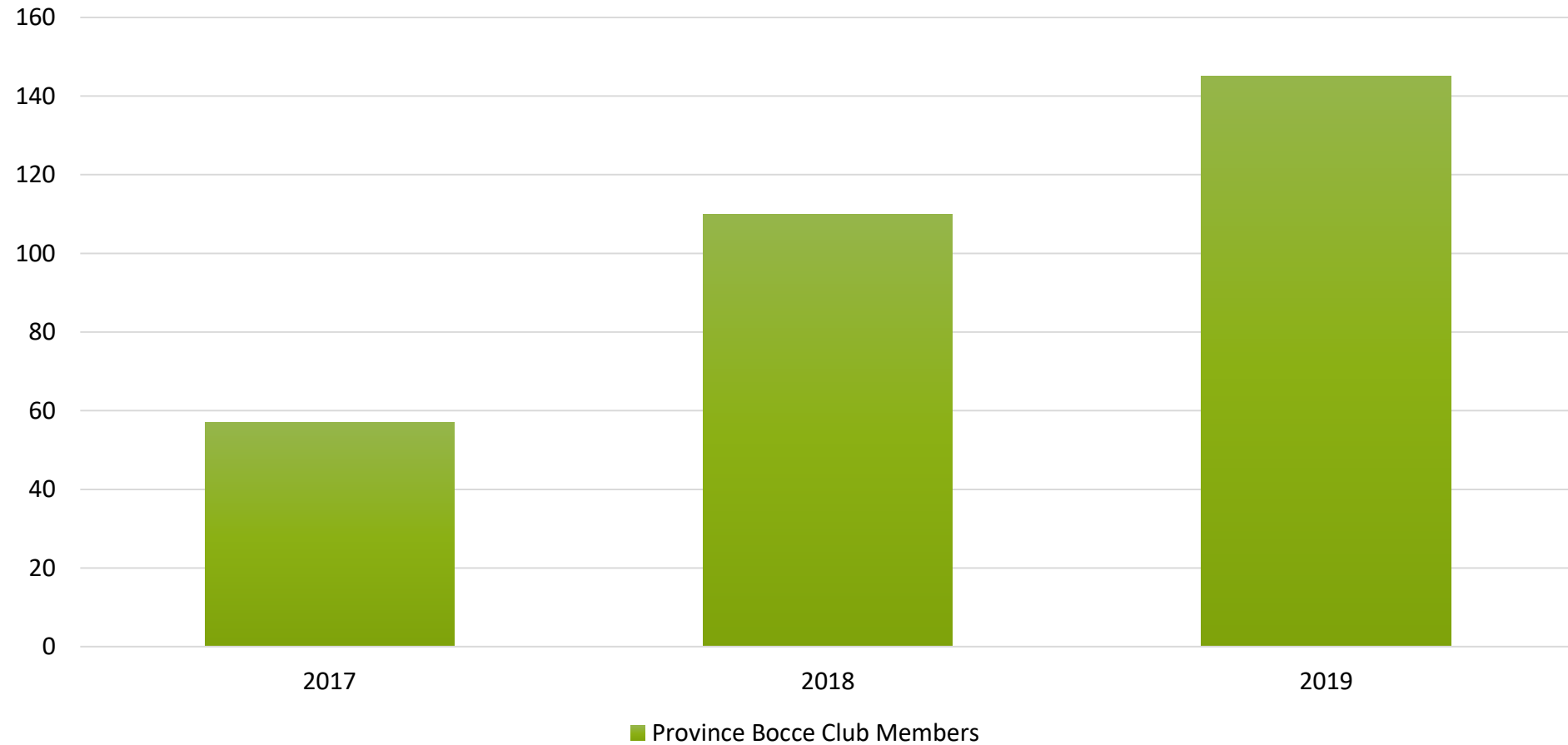
RETIREMENT COMMUNITY COMPARISONS

4 courts – 32 players

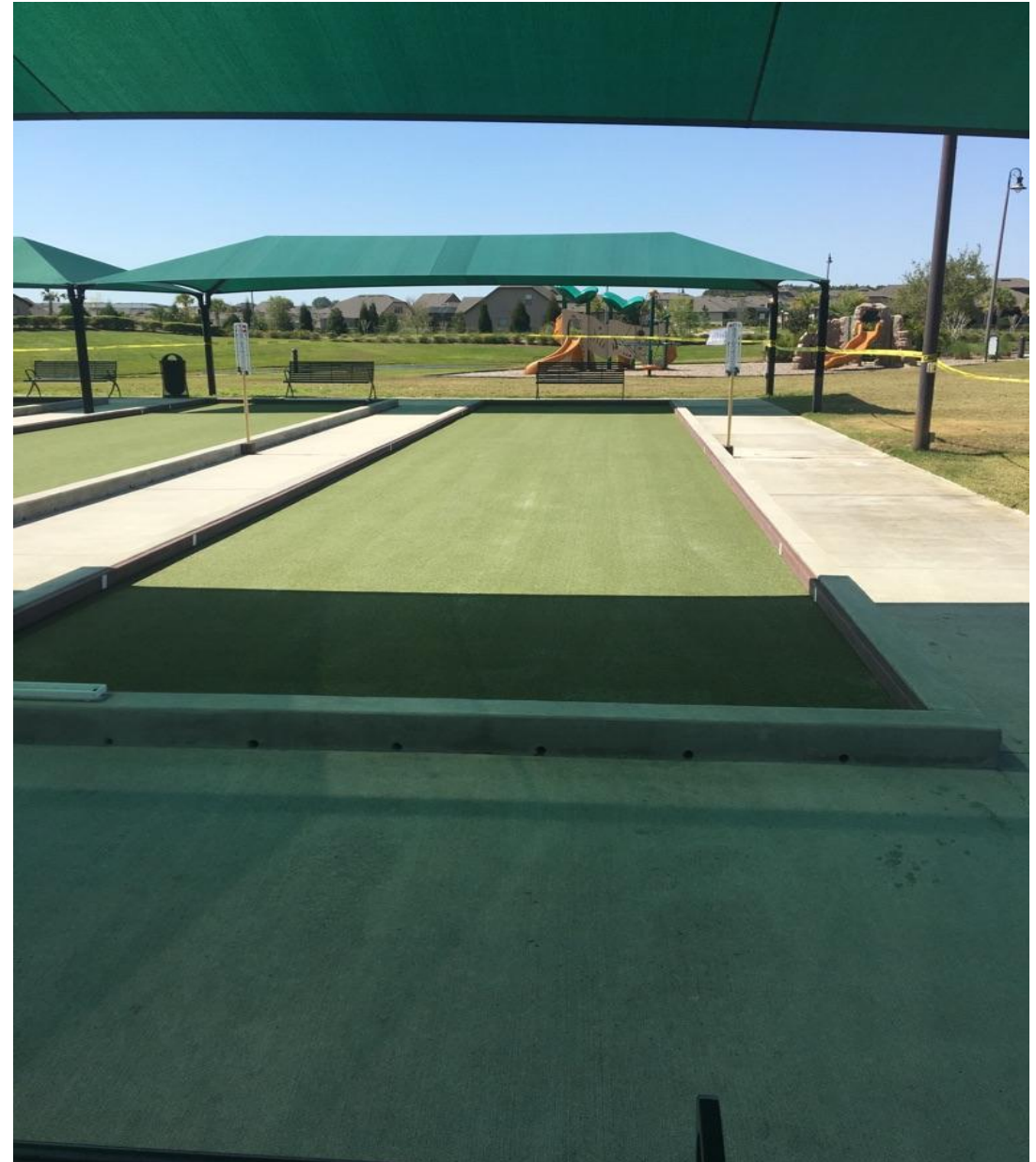
Utilize current space configuration

Remove rocks and replace with turf or cement

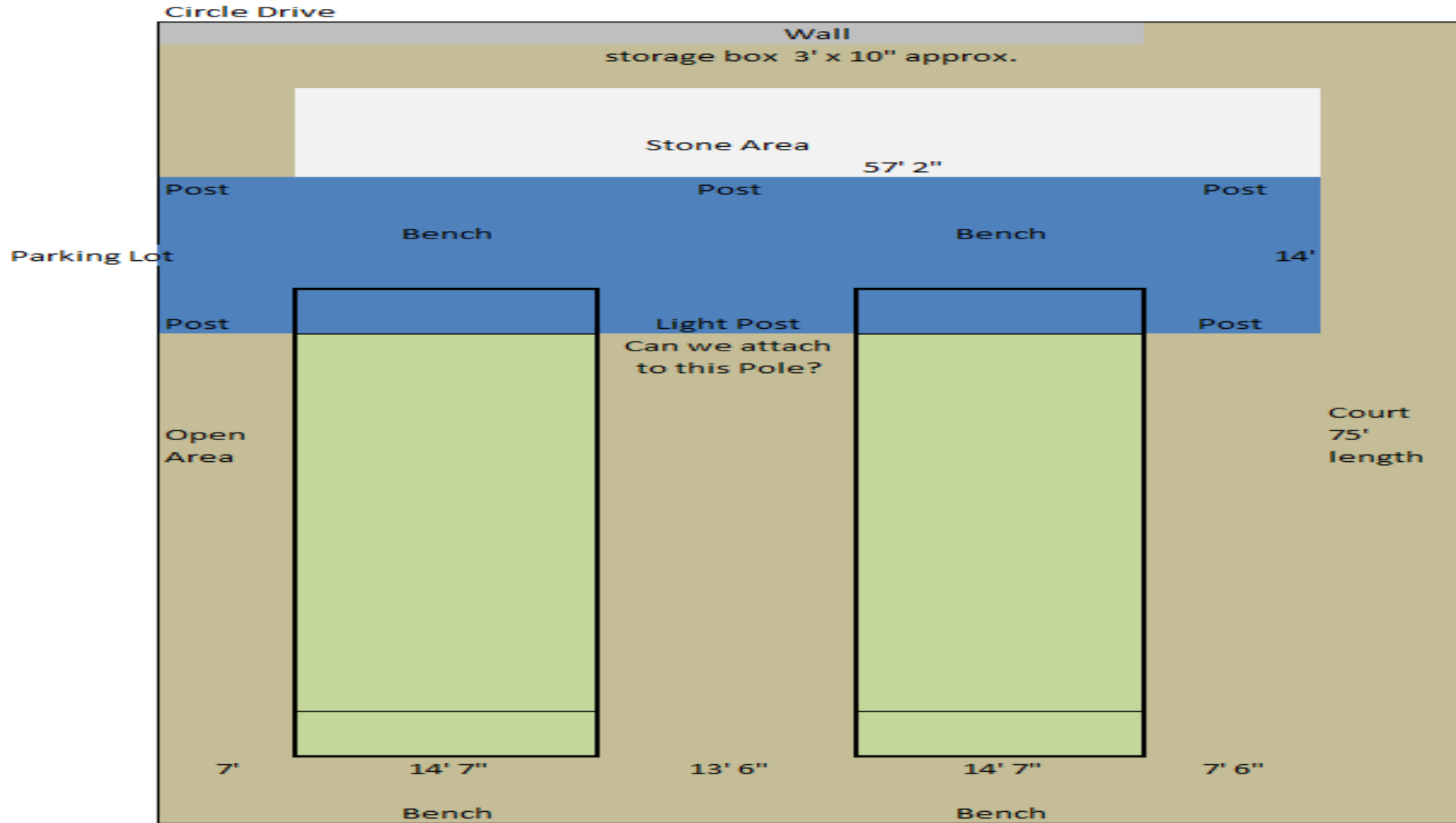
Add shade covers
(could be used for other Province events)

Improve benches and lighting

At least 1 court handicapped accessible



DESIGN SUGGESTIONS – SHADE COVER



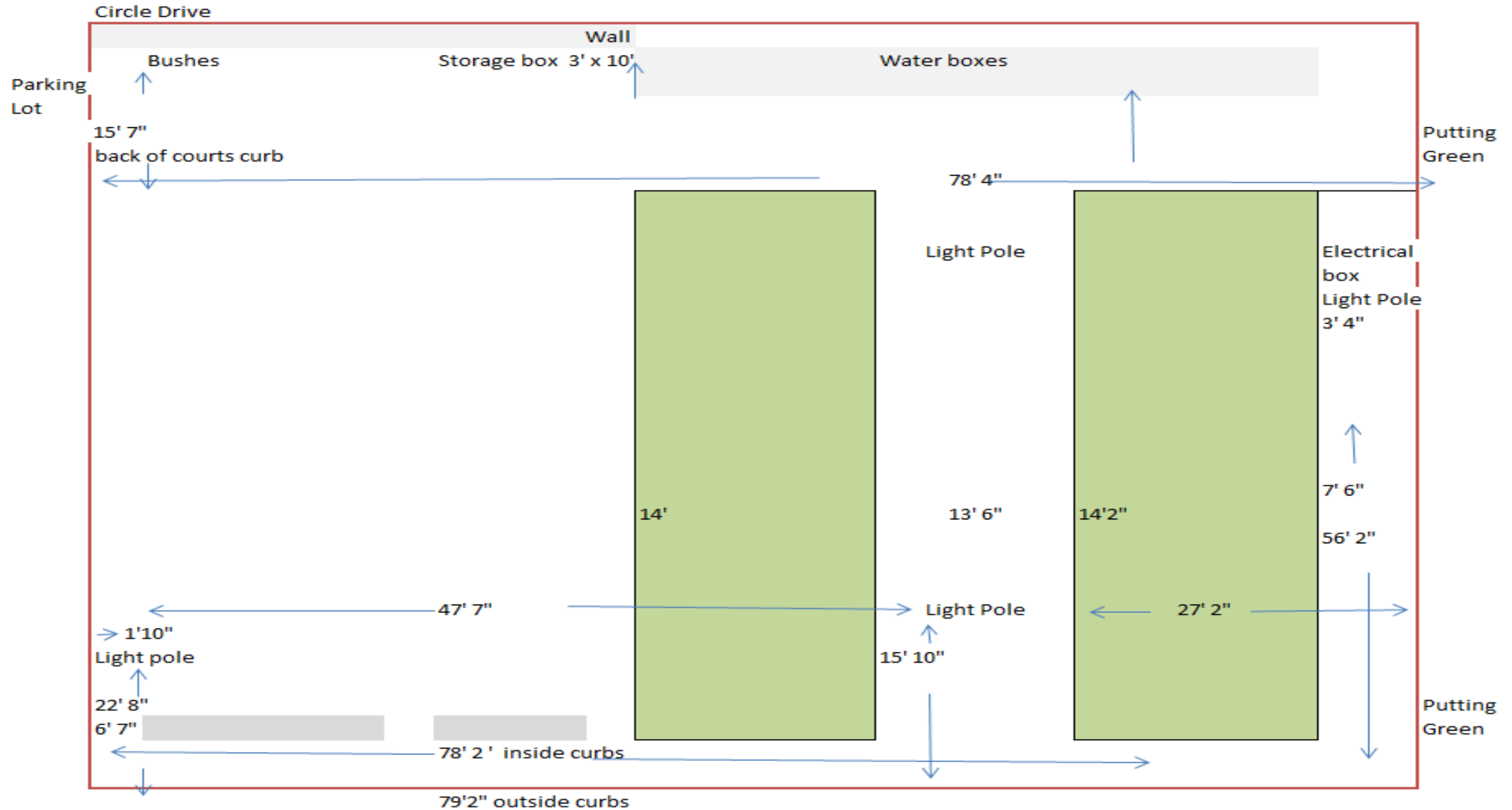
Covered area is the dark shaded area above.

Actual covered area to be based on 2 standard size tarps. Approx 12' x 25'

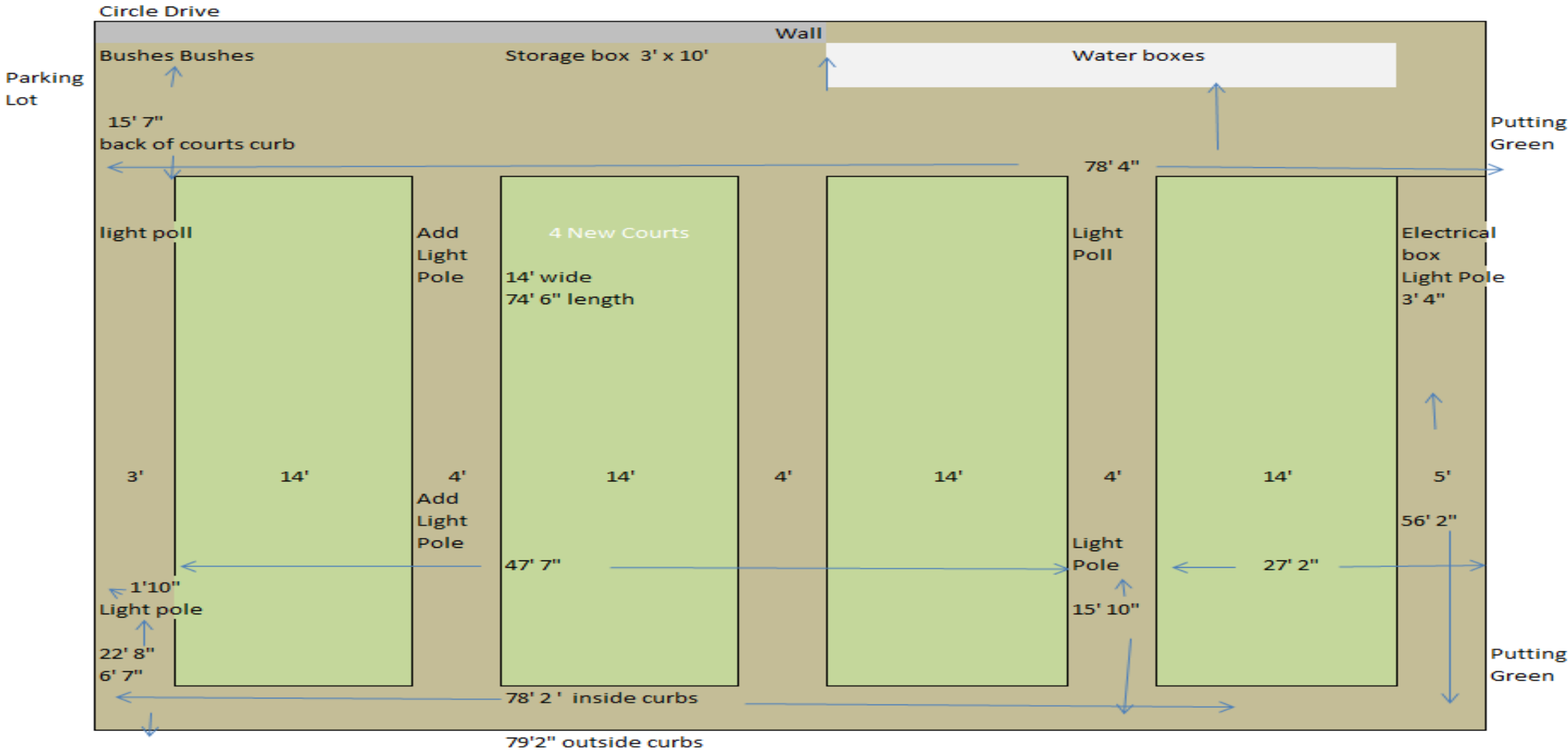
Need 5/6 Posts depending on if we can attach to existing light pole

Will look for other options to cover the above area based on HOA or building codes

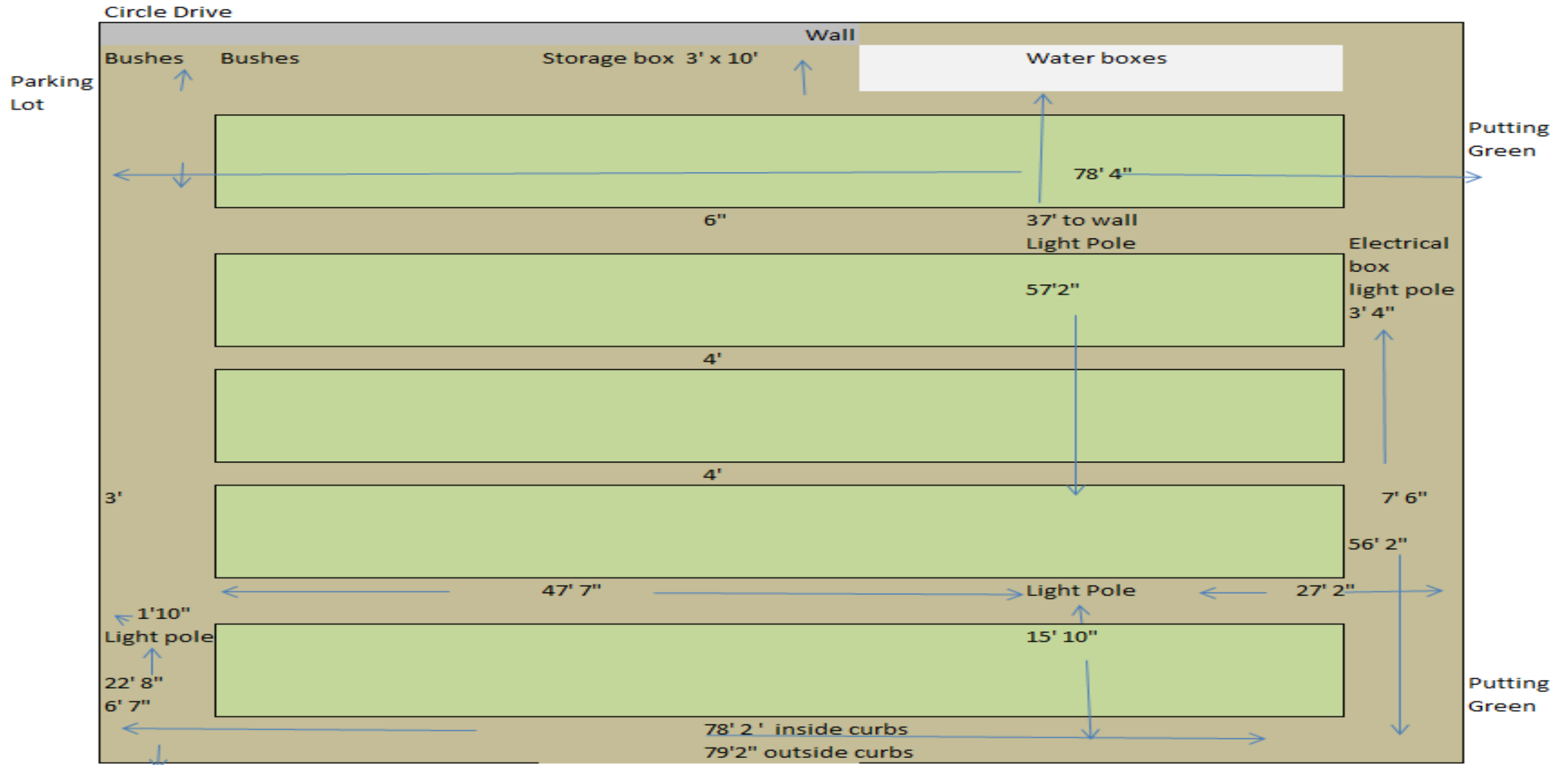


DESIGN SUGGESTIONS – 4 COURTS
