



PSSC Foundation Scholarship Student Application Instructions

Applicants for the McMicken Scholarship must be Sea-Tac residents. The Reba Gilman scholarship is to be used for a bachelor's degree. The Foundation award is for either higher education or advanced training. The Yormark award is intended for tools and equipment. Foundry 10 scholarships require only proof of registration for disbursement, and requests for awarded funds are to be submitted to directly to Foundry 10.

QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a senior graduating during the current school year.
- Apply for only one (1) Puget Sound Skills Center scholarship.
- Must have completed at least one year in a PSSC training program by graduation.

APPLICATION REVIEW AND SELECTION PROCESS

- An Award/Scholarship Selection Committee comprised of PSSC Foundation Members and PSSC Staff will review the applications using the following five-point rating scale.

0 Points	No Response
1 Points	Minimal Response
2 Points	Below Average Response
3 Points	Average Response
4 Points	Above Average Response
5 Points	Excellent Response

- Recipients will be notified by the first week of May. Scholarship funds will reimburse student with proof of purchase of tuition, books, program fees, or tools. Disbursements will be processed and mailed within 4 to 6 weeks of receipt submittal within 24 months of graduation.
- **Awardees will receive their award at PSSC Recognition Ceremonies at the Highline School District Performing Arts Center during graduation.**
