QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a senior graduating during the current school year.
- Apply for only one (1) Puget Sound Skills Center scholarship.
- Must have completed at least one year in a PSSC training program by graduation.

APPLICATION REVIEW AND SELECTION PROCESS

- An Award/Scholarship Selection Committee comprised of PSSC Foundation Members and PSSC Staff will review the applications using the following five-point rating scale.

0 Points	No Response
1 Points	Minimal Response
2 Points	Below Average Response
3 Points	Average Response
4 Points	Above Average Response
5 Points	Excellent Response

- Recipients of awards/scholarships will be notified in May. Scholarship funds will reimburse student with proof of purchase (receipt) of tuition, books, program fees, or tools.
- **Awardees will receive their award at the PSSC Recognition Ceremonies during graduation.**
