

This month the Lecturers on behalf of the Grange will host a potluck and film. The event is scheduled for Saturday August 23rd from 4-8pm. Jolinda is partnering with the Grange for this event. The film was originally her idea. Hopefully she will be at the meeting for questions or input.

Potluck: It will be from 4-6pm. Heather will help organize the Potluck which is great since she's done it many times. She is asking for volunteers to arrive at 2:30. We will set up both the potluck outside and the chairs inside for the film. **List of volunteers needed.**

We are hoping the Big Share will have a table and contribute to the Potluck. That is still to be confirmed.

Bob has an organization called Big Sur Stores. He will be available after the film to show a very short (5min) clip of his current project. He is interviewing Big Sur artists and residents for a follow up about Big Sur- the way it is now. He invites anyone who wants to contribute to the project to stay after the film.

The film is to begin about 6pm and runs for approximately an hour. We plan to wrap up and clean up by 8pm.
