Sad and Blue in District 2

Transparency • Accountability • Real Ethics • Election Integrity

For four years, District 2 has been represented inside a **5–0 One-Party Machine** on the Commissioners Court with virtually no real opposition or independent oversight. The result is a consistent pattern of failures in three priorities:

1st — Trust (radical associations, weakened election integrity, ethical conflicts)

2nd — Wallet (unchecked spending, debt without voter approval, new permanent taxes)

3rd — Safety (immigration enforcement, property rights, public-safety accountability)

Because District 2 already carries roughly **40%** of the county's tax burden, these failures hit this district first and hardest.

Trust

The incumbent used official power and taxpayer-funded communications to help establish mosque polling locations tied to networks Texas leaders have designated as terrorist organizations, then campaigned on the partisan result. A church, mosque, or synagogue can lawfully serve as a polling place. The problem is using private sites when public buildings are available, embedding election infrastructure in designated-network locations, and taking political credit for it.

IAANT in Richardson is the exhibit: he claimed credit for making it a vote center; in May 2025 that same mosque hosted an ICNA-sponsored “From Marxism to Islam” event. His official newsletter also linked to Fight Back! News, the publication of the Freedom Road Socialist Organization, a Marxist-Leninist group that calls for revolution and a new Communist Party.

He defended a countywide voting system that stripped ballot secrecy from **9,682** early voters in the March 2026 Primary — including **7,324 Democrats**. Public testimony documenting the problem was ignored.

He was introduced by County Judge Clay Jenkins as “my friend and my lawyer,” after representing Jenkins in COVID lawsuits to ban in-person worship, impose masks, and shut down businesses. His firm still practices in courts funded by the Commissioners Court.

Wallet

The Court approved **\$350 million** in Certificates of Obligation with no voter approval — about **\$700 million** with interest. District 2's share is about **\$280 million**, or **\$1,300 per person / \$2,600 if married**. That package included **\$25 million** for a deflection center in District 2.

The incumbent then voted to raise the base tax rate and to put a permanent homelessness tax on the November ballot. Official notices show a rate increase of **17.47%** and a homestead-bill increase closer to **25%**. District 2 would shoulder tens of millions of that new annual cost.

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He also proposed raising landlord eviction fees from **\$70 to \$400**, directed taxpayer money into special housing deals with “golden handcuffs,” and joined spending at Metrocare without a countywide independent forensic audit.

The Court unanimously approved Parkland’s FY2026 operating budget of **\$3.14 billion**, plus **\$132.9 million** in capital projects. Local property taxes still fund nearly one-third of Parkland’s revenue — more than **\$800 million** from Dallas County taxpayers, with District 2 carrying a disproportionate share. That budget was approved even though Parkland projected an operating loss of about **\$22 million**. Salaries and benefits rose **4.7%**, benefits **6.4%**, supplies **6.1%**, and drugs **7.0%**, with no independent forensic audit showing where the money goes.

Safety

He accepted the Sheriff’s excuses on 287(g) and ICE detainers, then told Richardson Democrats not to open the door if ICE knocks. He opposed bipartisan squatter-reform legislation and joined the full Court and a well-funded establishment campaign against Dallas HERO Propositions S, T, and U.
