

Camp Verde Equestrian Center Rodeo and Events COVID-19 Plan 2021

Purpose:

In order to slow the spread of COVID-19 and reduce the health risk for attendees, vendors, volunteers and staff of Camp Verde Equestrian Center and CVAA activities the following actions & policies will be utilized during the event.

Event design:

The rodeo and equine related events are outside events. No portion of the event shall be held inside. The events will be held in the two arenas so the contestants and spectators can have social distancing space. Events will be held at the Camp Verde Equestrian Center at 1495 E. Hideout Arena Way in Camp Verde.

Policies:

- All CVAA staff and volunteers shall wear face masks if unable to socially distance while at the event.
- Any CVAA staff and/or volunteers will be encouraged to remain home if they are sick.
- All CVAA staff and volunteers will use hand sanitizer and clean surfaces as needed.
- Contestant parking locations shall be assigned distant from other contestant to meet social distancing.
- Contestant and spectators shall maintain social distancing when situations are available.

Actions:

Staff & Volunteers –

All staff and volunteers working at the event shall wear a face mask when unable to maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from other staff, volunteers, participants or the viewing public.

- Adequate cleaning supplies shall be on hand and utilized to sanitize work surfaces as needed, as per CDC guidelines.
- Dispose gloves shall be used when cleaning touch point areas and other surface areas during the event.
- Hand sanitizer stations and hand washing stations shall be available and utilized by staff and volunteers as needed as per CDC guidelines..
- Disposable face masks shall be available for use as per CDC guidelines at the entrance location.
- Cleaning wipes will be used as needed on surfaces in vendor areas.
- Food vendors will be asked to follow OSHA's COVID 19 Guidance for Food Truck Workers during the event.
- Announcements will be made on the Public Address System on wearing of a mask and social distancing when available. The COVID guidelines will be posted on the CVAA & AHSRA websites in advance.

Rodeo and equine related event participants

- Participants Vehicles shall be placed a significant distance from vehicles – minimum 8'.
- Participants shall remain socially distanced from others when not in the competition or warm up area.
- Individuals in participant groups who are not in the same household will wear face masks when unable to socially distance and not competing.
- Participants will only enter the competition area when their events are being held and shall wear mask if possible.

Rodeo and equine related event spectators

- Spectator capacity in the grandstands will be reduced to 50% capacity.
- Spectators will be advised to wear a mask when social distancing of 6' cannot be maintained.
- Spectators will be advised to maintain social distancing of 6' when available and not with same household members. -

Signs shall be posted at the following locations:

Event Check in Station, Spectator Entrance to main and second arena, Each end of Main Bleachers, and Posted on the arena fence in front of the main bleachers with the following information:

- Please socially distance
- Masks highly recommended
- Wash hands often
