Go for the Gold – celebrating 50 years of Fort Verde State Historic Park

- Show us your accomplishments over the last 50 years (since 1970)
- Show us Then and Now related to the Fort and Community
- Categories of Business, Community, Family
- Fort Verde became a State Park in 1970 after years of volunteer preservation work by community members and broad based support of the community in general. Fundraising efforts, repair work, advocacy and a community museum helped to preserve and call attention to the Fort as a historic asset to the State and larger world. A focal point of the early Anglo-European settlement of the Verde Valley, Fort Verde played an important role in history. Today the Fort celebrates 50 years of interpretation and preservation around a turbulent period of Arizona history.
