About Chesham: Chesham is a bustling market town and civil parish situated in Buckinghamshire, England, United Kingdom. With a population of 23,056 and 8,176 households (2020 census), it is the largest town in the Chiltern district.

Where the London Underground (end of the Metropolitan Line) meets the Chilterns – An Area of Natural Beauty, Chesham is situated in the Chess Valley, surrounded by park and farmland with great local attractions to visit.

It is 11 miles (18 km) south-east of the county town of Aylesbury, 25.8 miles (41.5 km) north-west of central London and part of the London commuter belt. Luton airport is 15 miles away and Heathrow airport 22 miles away.

Chesham is known for its four Bs — Boots, Beer, Brushes and Baptists and not forgetting C for Creativity!!
