





THIRD DEGREE BLACK BELT CANDIDATE SPECIAL PROJECTS


Dear Fastkix Family,

BOARD BREAKING COMPETITION RULES

- Boards must be purchased at event. To ensure fair competition, competitors may not bring own boards. All boards are subject to inspection.
- 90 second round (setup and break) with 10 board maximum per round
- Competitors <u>must</u> have their own coaches/holders to hold their boards. Any special breaking apparatus must be supplied by competitor. <u>(ALL</u> <u>coaches/holders on the competition floor must be registered AAU coaches.</u> <u>No exceptions)</u>
- No forehead breaking, open flames, blades or human obstacles may be used
- For multiple board techniques, if competitor fails to break all boards, they may reset to the original number of boards, but that attempt will count as a failed attempt for scoring
- · Athletes will be judges on technique, focus, balance, power and creativity
- Single elimination
