1. Overview

Chris Brown for State Representative (the “Campaign,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and share information when you visit our website (the “Site”) or interact with the Campaign online.

2. Information We Collect

A. Information You Provide Voluntarily

We may collect personal information that you voluntarily provide, including:

- Name
- Email address
- Phone number
- Mailing address
- Occupation and employer (for contributions, if required)
- Any other information you submit through forms, sign-ups, or communications

B. Contribution Information

If you make a contribution, additional information may be collected as required for processing and compliance with applicable laws, including payment details (processed securely through third-party vendors).

C. Automatically Collected Information

When you visit the Site, we may automatically collect certain information, including:

- IP address
- Browser type
- Device information
- Pages visited and time spent on the Site

This information may be collected using cookies or similar tracking technologies.

3. How We Use Your Information

We may use the information we collect to:

- Communicate with you about the Campaign
 - Send updates, newsletters, and event information
 - Process contributions and maintain required financial records
 - Respond to inquiries or requests
 - Improve the performance and functionality of the Site
 - Comply with legal and reporting obligations under Vermont and federal law
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4. Sharing of Information

We do not sell your personal information.

We may share your information:

- With trusted service providers (such as email platforms, donation processors, or website hosting providers) solely to support campaign operations
 - As required by law, including reporting contributions to the Vermont Secretary of State
 - To protect the rights, safety, or integrity of the Campaign or the public
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5. Campaign Finance Disclosure

Under Vermont law, political campaigns are required to report certain contributor information to the Vermont Secretary of State.

For contributions over applicable thresholds, this may include:

- Name
- Mailing address
- Contribution amount and date
- Occupation and employer (if required)

This information may become publicly available through the state's campaign finance reporting system.

6. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

The Site may use cookies or similar technologies to:

- Understand how visitors use the Site
- Improve user experience
- Support campaign outreach efforts

You may adjust your browser settings to refuse cookies; however, some parts of the Site may not function properly.

7. Third-Party Services

This Site may use third-party services, including:

- Donation processors
- Email communication platforms
- Analytics tools
- Social media integrations

These third parties have their own privacy policies governing how they handle your information. The Campaign is not responsible for the privacy practices of third-party services.

8. Data Security

We take reasonable administrative and technical measures to protect your information. However, no method of transmission over the internet is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

9. Your Choices

You may:

- Unsubscribe from email communications using the link provided in emails
 - Opt out of text messages by following instructions in the message
 - Contact us to update or request removal of your information, where applicable
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10. Children's Privacy

This Site is not intended for children under the age of 13, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children.

11. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. Any changes will be posted on this page with an updated effective date.

12. Governing Law

This Privacy Policy is governed by the laws of the State of Vermont.
