
Mrs. Edina's Math and Science Welcome Letter

Students who are not picked up at dismissal time will be taken to the school office after 3:40pm.

School uniform is mandatory, so please make sure that from day one your child comes to school dressed following the proper uniform code which includes light/baby blue blouse or shirt and navy-blue pants or skirt/jumper. Supply list for all the grades is available on the school website.

During the first week of school we will get to know each other through various activities. Together we will practice daily routines, become familiar with our daily schedule, and talk about our goals and expectations for this school year. I will also give students a pretest to assess their knowledge and see what their levels are.
