They practiced writing numbers, learning about animals through animal planet and books, learning the vowels and their sounds. We also discussed countries around the world. Your child also started writing in their notebooks so please check to see their journaling for the day!

This weekend, please help your child get organized. Please look in their backpacks to make sure their worksheets are in order and inside of the appropriate folder. Also, I would like the kids to continue reading their new book with you.

I am still assessing your child using a simple test. I want to see their progress through the year. Insha'ALLAH I hope to finish testing them next week.
