Arrival and Dismissal

What is your child learning about this week?

Math: Learning how to say, write, and count numbers 4-8. Children will practice counting blocks and beads.

English: Learning the letter B b how to pronounce it, say it, and write it. Students will also learn new words such as: buttons, bears, bugs, bubbles, and birds. Children will learn a new word each day with the letter B b. Students will do fun activities with these new words.

Reading: This week in September, the theme will be bears, so we will be reading a lot of books about bears.
