· We will read our story of the week, discuss for comprehension, learn new words and definition.

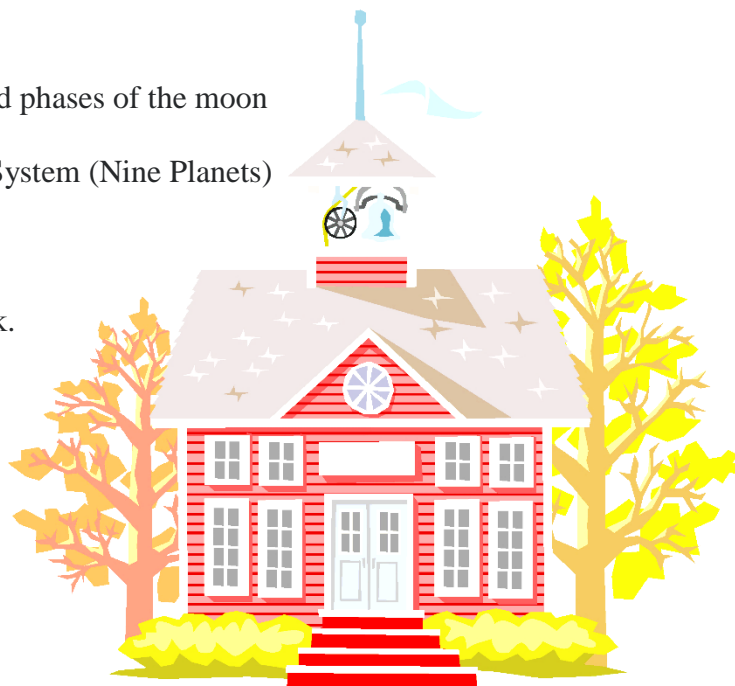
For grammar we will focus on synonyms and learn commas in a dialogue.
