As the upcoming decodable texts are becoming longer and longer as we progress in the reading curriculum, I will be introducing a new change to our reading fluency tests.

Instead of these being weekly tests were students read an entire decodable text, students will be tested by reading a few sentences (10-15). This will only happen every 4-5 weeks.

However, students will NOT receive the reading fluency test paper home to practice to give me an accurate understanding on where the student is in their reading journey. You can help them by continuing to read the decodable texts being sent home as the sight words, and other words will still be assessed. We will test this out with a reading fluency test on February 5th.
