Centers

For Daily 5, I have introduced a listening station, a writing station, and the library. We are taking extra precautions and several cleaning procedures are put into place to ensure no one is going home with any harmful germs.

I have also introduced math centers which was a hit with the students. They enjoyed the centers so much and loving math at the same time. I have introduced many manipulatives to review what we learned during whole group instruction.

Important Information
