Grade 5: Students will learn about how to divide fractions and whole numbers to form fractions, scaling, and how to solve for fractions in word problems. They will review fractions and scaling for the test.

Grade 6: Students will continue learning about GCF and LCM and will start learning about integers and rational numbers. They will review percents, decimals, integers, and rational numbers for the test.

Grade 7: Students will be learning about how to convert a rational number to a decimal. We will continue rates, ratios, and unit rates. Rational numbers, integers, rates, and proportional relationships will be reviewed for the test.

Grade 8: Students will learn about linear equations and how to solve them. We will review proportional and nonproportional relationships, functions, and linear equations for the test.



Grade 5 & 6: Students will continue the different biomes (Tundra, Taiga, Desert, Grassland, Tropical rain forest, and Deciduous forest). We will review the biomes for the quiz (B62- B71).

Grade 7 & 8: Students will continue learning about mitosis and meiosis We will review for the science quiz about mitosis and meiosis (p.58-61, 96-97).
