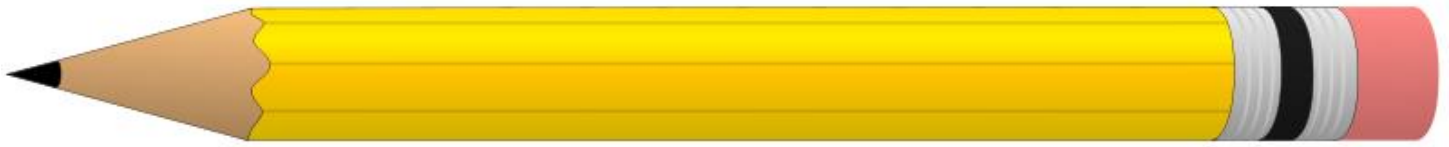


# Third Grade Newsletter
