Reports from Local Organizations

Mayor's Office Ward 3 Councilmember Frumin's Office American University

Washington Ballet Request for 2-Year Extension for Renovation Project at 3515 Wisconsin Avenue The Washington Ballet is asking the DC Bureau of Zoning Adjustment (BZA) to approve a 2-year extension of the approval for the planned renovation project at the corner of Wisconsin Avenue and Porter Street (BZA Order No. 20970), which was granted in the initial zoning case in 2023 and will expire on December 20, 2025. The extension will allow the applicant to have more time to conduct its capital fundraising campaign to support the project. The applicant will attend the meeting. ANC 3A will consider a resolution to support the requested extension (BZA Case 20970A) within the 30-day comment period.

DC Preservation League presentation on Proposed Grant for impact study of DC historic districts. This presentation was postponed from October. For the 75th anniversary of the first historic district established in the city, in Georgetown in 1950, the DC Preservation League proposed to the DC Office of Planning (OP) that a study be conducted of the effects that historic preservation programs have had in the five historic districts in Washington, DC, with the thought that the study could provide input to OP's current project to rewrite the DC Comprehensive Plan ("DC 2050"). OP encouraged the Preservation League to conduct the study. The Preservation League submitted an application to the Office of ANCs (OANC) for ANC grant funds to support the study, and early in the summer OANC issued a letter confirming that the study would be a legal use of ANC grant funds. The grant request is going to all 7 ANCs that have within their boundaries some or part of DC's 5 historic districts. The Cleveland Park Historic District is partly within ANC 3A and partly within ANC 3C. The Preservation League proposes to conduct field research such as interviews in the communities in the ANC. The requested grant would be \$2,500. The ANC invites comments on the proposed grant and plans to discuss the proposal at the time of the presentation. Comments can be emailed to 3A@anc.dc.gov or to individual Commissioners.

Discussion and Possible Vote on Legislation B26-0465 to change the method of filling vacant ANC seats Councilmember Anita Bonds introduced the bill in November 2025 which would transfer responsibility of special elections for ANC Commissioner from the Office of ANCs to the DC Board of Elections, would call for the other Commissioners on an ANC to select the new Commissioners by vote at an ANC public meeting whenever more than one candidate registers to run for an open seat on the ANC, and would allow other Commissioner to make that choice even if there is not a quorum at the public meeting at which the vote for a new Commissioner is taken, and would clarify the date that an ANC seat is official considered open. The DC Council held a hearing on the proposed bill on December 5, and will accept comments through December 19. The ANC will consider a vote on comments to submit to the Council on the legislation.


