#### Election of ANC 3A Officers for 2026

A neutral third party from the community will be asked to preside over the election of ANC 3A officers to serve through December 2026. Commissioners can nominate themselves or other Commissioners for the four ANC offices: Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer and Secretary. Commissioners will take a voice vote. Tie votes will be broken by lot. The newly elected Chair will then preside over the rest of the meeting.

#### MPD Community Report

##### Vote on Resolution Urging DDOT to Respond to ANC Traffic Safety Concerns on Reno Road

After two recent incidents of children struck by vehicles on Reno Road and several years that nearby ANCs and constituents have asked the DC Department of Transportation (DDOT) for traffic data and a timeline for addressing traffic safety challenges on the 34<sup>th</sup> Street/Reno Road corridor, the ANC will consider a resolution asking DDOT to respond to the ANCs' requests.

##### Vote to Submit Comments on Acqua Bistecca request to add an Entertainment Endorsement

At the ANC 3A December meeting, Acqua Bistecca presented its proposal for amending its liquor license at 10 Ridge Square to allow live entertainment as well as dancing by patrons and a cover charge, indoors and on the summer garden, 7 days a week, all day through closing (currently 2 am). ANC 3A will consider a vote on comments on that request. Comments are due to the DC Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board (ABCA) by January 26. Petitions and/or requests to appear before the ABC Board must be filed electronically to [abca.legal@dc.gov](mailto:abca.legal@dc.gov) on or before that date. Constituents should provide any comments to [3A@anc.dc.gov](mailto:3A@anc.dc.gov) before the January 20 public meeting. ABCA's Roll Call Hearing would be February 17. (NOTE: At its December meeting, ANC 3A voted to support a stipulated license to allow the restaurant to provide entertainment until comments are collected on the long-term application.)

#### Commissioner Updates

- Update on ANC 3A grant for Friends of Hearst Park approved in November and completed in December
- Update on proposed text amendment being considered by the Zoning Commission (Case ZC 25-13) to "upzone" the Wisconsin Avenue corridor in ANC 3A and ANC 3E as part of carrying out Wisconsin Avenue Development Framework the DC Office of Planning (OP) adopted in February 2024. ANC 3A submitted comments for the Zoning Commission hearing on December 11, asking for further public outreach, more information, and provisions for more affordable housing. The Zoning Commission agreed to extend the review of the proposal and ask OP to respond to questions posed at the hearing. Several local groups have asked the DC Council to intervene to ensure additional public participation.
- Update on Legislation B26-0465 to change the method of filling vacant ANC seats, which was introduced by Councilmember Anita Bonds in November 2025 and was the subject of a hearing on December 5. ANC 3A voted at its December public meeting to oppose the proposed provisions to have the sitting Commissioners on the ANC to vote on who should fill an empty seat if more than one candidate registers to run, instead of having constituents vote, and waive the requirement for a quorum and allow as few as two Commissioners to vote on a new Commissioner to fill a vacant seat.

- The second fall leaf collection in ANC 3A is planned for late January, as part of “Area C.” See: <https://dpw.dc.gov/leaf> The DC Department of Public Works (DPW) will also collect holiday trees and greenery through February 28 from DPW-serviced households, which include single-family homes and apartment dwellings with three or fewer units. Holiday trees and greenery should be placed in the tree at the curb in the front of the residence, and should be free of ornaments, lights, and tinsel and. Trees and greenery collected during this time will be used to produce mulch to support Mayor Bowser’s Zero Waste initiative. If holiday trees and greenery are not picked up 7 days after being placed at the curbside, residents can call 311 and make a service request for “Christmas Tree Removal – Seasonal.”
- Exelon and Pepco have announced there are additional funds this year in their Customer Relief Fund to help customers manage higher energy costs during the winter months, at a time when cost pressures are most acute.
