
**Resolution in Support of Stipulated License  
for Augie’s at 3228 Wisconsin Avenue NW (ABCA-135310).**

Augie’s Cathedral Heights, a new restaurant located at 3228 Wisconsin Avenue NW, Washington, DC, 20016, has applied to the DC Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration (ABCA) for a Retailer Class C license with an Endorsement for Sidewalk Café and Live Entertainment. The establishment has also requested ANC 3A support for a stipulated license to allow the requested alcoholic beverage service, as well as service on the sidewalk café and live entertainment, to be permitted immediately and remain in effect until the ABCA has collected full comments about the application for a longer-term license.

We understand that ABCA requires support from the affected ANC for a requested stipulated license. The ANC included this case on the proposed agenda circulated throughout ANC 3A the required 7 days in advance, noting the ABCA case number, nature of the application, and the request for a stipulated license. We also invited public comments on the requests. At the duly noticed ANC 3A public meeting on March 17, 2026, at which all five Commissioners were present, we hosted a presentation by the applicant about its plans for the restaurant, alcoholic beverage service, sidewalk café and live entertainment. No one at or before the meeting submitted any comments expressing concerns or objections to the proposed operations or endorsements or to the stipulated license. The applicant explained that it was planning for food and beverage service on the sidewalk café to end several hours earlier than the hours proposed for the restaurant as a whole and for live entertainment to involve solo performers such as solo acoustic guitar to be held indoors only. Following the presentation, the ANC 3A Commissioners discussed the benefits of a stipulated license, including to allow the restaurant to begin operations with the full range of planned food and beverage options from the first day it is open, along with the types of live entertainment it is planning for the longer term, and also to give the ANC a chance to consider any comments or concerns on the restaurant operations while the stipulated license is in effect. For that reason, granting a stipulated license would provide the Commissioners a chance to consider the effects of planned operations at Augie’s before voting on an official position on the full application at our April public meeting, in time to make the April 27 protest deadline in ABCA-135310.

Therefore, ANC 3A supports the applicant’s request for a stipulated license for Augie’s Cathedral Heights.
