Resolution supporting change in speed limit from 30 mph to 25 mph on Wisconsin Avenue NW between Western Avenue and Cathedral Avenue (NOI 24-189-TESD)

As part of "Vision Zero" to improve traffic safety, the DC Department of Transportation (DDOT) has proposed to lower the speed limit on Wisconsin Avenue between Western Avenue NW and Cathedral Avenue NW from 30 mph to 25 mph.

ANC 3A has received the formal Notification of Intent from DDOT in NOI 24-189-TESD, dated July 12, 2024, notifying the Commission of the proposed change. DDOT has requested comments by August 26, 2024.

The portion of Wisconsin Avenue covered by the proposed change includes most the blocks of Wisconsin Avenue that pass through ANC 3A, from Cathedral Avenue to Tenley Circle, as well as blocks in ANC 3C and ANC 3E.

DDOT has determined that this change is necessary and important in order to carry out the objectives of "Vision Zero" and meet transportation safety standards, based on federal guidelines and an analysis of traffic volumes, traffic speed data, crash history, the nature of the roadway and its overall context.

Safety is the #1 priority for DDOT, and public safety including on streets and sidewalks is also a top priority for the Advisory Neighborhood Commission as well.

Therefore be it resolved that ANC 3A supports the DDOT proposal to change the speed limit from 30 mph to 25 mph on Wisconsin Avenue NW, in the blocks identified in NOI 24-189-TESD including the blocks in and adjoining ANC 3A.

This resolution was approved by the Commission by a vote of 3 - 0 at its duly noticed public meeting on July 16, 2024, at which a quorum was present. (Three of the Commissioners constitute a quorum.) By this vote, the Commission also designated the Chair or his designee(s) to represent ANC 3A on this matter.
