

Guibord's Safety Guidelines

Based on facts Guibord's has made some decisions and changes so that we can continue to operate as safely as possible

We have reduced studio capacity

We are sanitizing surfaces in between classes

We are adhering to 6' of space between students

Each student is required to wear a mask upon entering and during class

Windows in the studio will be kept slightly opened to allow for ventilation

School age children will enter Guibord's with out a parent

Enter the building keeping your distance from another dancer

Younger children in this grouping will be released when their instructor sees that their parent has pulled up by the entrance door. Parent please place your dancers name visible in the passenger window so we know to let your child exit.

It is important to be on time for pick up.

Kinder Ballet students will enter with **one** parent/guardian.

There will be up to 6 students in class

This will allow 2 parents to wait in three different spaces to keep spacing as necessary.

No siblings will be allowed in the studio

Toys will not be offered to play with while waiting for class to begin

Students enter the studio dressed for class with hair done carrying their dance shoes

Hand Sanitizer

Students enter the studio need to immediately use hand sanitizer provided

When leaving the studio hand sanitizer is again used

*If possible please bring your own hand sanitizer to use regular throughout your time at the studio

Wash Hands if you use the Bathroom

Wearing a Mask for All Students

Each student is required to wear a mask upon entering and during class

Windows in the studio will be kept slightly opened to allow for ventilation

As the weather cools have your dancer wear a light sweater

Guibord's has masks available at no cost to your dancer

Lockers

Lockers will be assigned with your dancers name on it for outer wear

Nothing is to be left in lockers so that disaffecting can be completed daily

There will be no "lost & found" at this time so be sure to leave with your personnel items

In the Classroom

Students will be spaced apart

For *younger dancers* a spot will be on the floor marking for them where to be

Please explain to your child that it is important that they stay on their spot. Thank you!

For some groupings that would need to share a ballet barre or such the equipment will be sanitized between classes

For *younger dancers* "props" from the class before them will not be used again in the next grouping of students that day and than can be sanitized
