Course Description:

This course is designed for students who are serious about being effective instructors and leaders. The student's primary goal is teaching effective tactical employment of the tactical rifle to your officers. Students will learn how to teach tactical rifle operator course modules and how to incorporate CSAT training methodologies into their agency's training framework. Student instructors will learn, practice and demonstrate CSAT methods to develop and enhance the technical and tactical skills for the officers in your agency. The class will focus on the following:

- Safety
- Instructional Techniques
- Threat Discrimination
- Instructing Weapon Zero, Standard and Non-standard Shooting Positions, Proper positions for distance
- Use of Cover and Movement Tactics Instruction
- Shooting Plan Development and Surgical Shooting
- Target and drill selection, including drill development to accomplish your specific goals
- Proper range set up and training development for agency training days

Prerequisites: Instructor students must already be Colorado POST Certified instructors, and must have taken the 2-day Tactical Rifle Operator course. In lieu of the 2-day course, a 1-day operator course may be taken within 30 days prior to this class. All students will be provided video well in advance from which to prepare for this instructor course. I am requiring this because this is a stair-stepped training methodology and too much is missed without significant exposure to the skills presented in the operator course.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Tactical gear or Patrol rig to include rifle, 3 magazines and pouches, pistol, holster, magazines, eye and ear protection. Bring water and inclement weather gear. Also, bring weapon cleaning equipment. 1000 RIFLE AND 200 PISTOL ROUNDS. The instructor will provide handouts electronically.
