Safety	Target and Gear Selection and Use
Pistol/Rifle Skills Calibration	Interior, Exterior and Vehicle Tactical Skills
Technical Skills Calibration	Tactical Decision Making
Range Setup	Teaching before Testing

This course will focus on tactical instruction concepts for real world application for patrol and tactical officers.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: Good Physical shape. Short sprints will be done during the training.
