Dinwiddie stripping him out of his protective gear and performing CPR on him. I reached out and grasped Det. Dinwiddie's leg. I pleaded with him to "Wake up! Don't give up! Fight!" At this point, I recall hearing Detective Petty shout commands to whoever was still inside the apartment to, "Come out with your hands up in the air!" I then remember stripping out of my protective vest and gear so that EMS personnel could get me to the ambulance without the weight of my protective gear bearing on them. When we got into the ambulance I remember being treated by Killeen EMS personnel as they transported me to Scott & White Hospital.

- 5-21-14 – On May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2014 I was sleeping when I was awoken to a large boom where I woke up ....gunshots....so I went out to my living room and look out my window to see what was going on and I see a bunch of police cars and police officers. Not hear any yelling or sirens.

- 5-9-14 – Approximately 6:30pm I arrived home to check on my daughter purchased her dinner Marvin asked if I would come over we were arguing prior to our visit got curious and went to his house he asked if he could me to my house I told him no. So went to his house going forward then I gather some clothes to stay at his house came over here continue to drive around he didn't \_\_\_? The house approximately 2AM we argued until about 3:00 I told him I gotta take my daughter to school so I am leaving at six o'clock I fell asleep I assume he slept he was in the front bedroom all of a sudden I heard fire works glass shatter. I rolled out the bed onto the floor into the closet and saw blue light and someone asking is there anyone in the come out with your hand up walk slowly towards the voice. I proceeded to and I got football tackled to the ground. From their I just was sick to my stomach. I lost control of my bowels? and I was embarrassed to have been apart of all of this. I was in the back bedroom. I was not aware of Marvin placing a large chair recliner in front of the door. He normally just lock the two locks dead bolt and door knob lock. I've never known Marvin to have guns, no I don't have gun. I didn't fire any weapons anytime. A few months ago Marvin showed me a target Practice sheet. He was like a kid elated he went to a target range. I willing to take a polygraph.

108. **Written Witness Statement of Tarianna Velasquez**

- 5-21-14 – As I woke up at 5:45 that Friday morning I heard gunshots, so I ran to my son room to see what was going on and I saw SWAP and police men all over. I had to go to work but my street was completely closed off. I couldn't see much because I didn't know what was going on because I was trying to protect my kids.

109. **Written Witness Statement of Tatanisha Mcall**

- 5-20-14 – I heard gunshots, but I didn't see anything I was in my room sleeping.

110. **Written Witness Statement of Toy Seawood**

- 5-20-14 – On the morning of May 9<sup>th</sup>, I woke up to the sound of several gunshots. I immediately ran to the girls room because it sounded close to our apartment. When I realized it was outside, I went to the front door to see what was going on. I was told by an officer to return back inside. My daughters, one young age 7 and Hemmingway Nevahage 4 were asleep at the time of the occurrence.

111. **Written Witness Statement of Xavier Clark (Killeen PD)**

- 5-28-14 – On 5-9-14 at approximately 4:30am, the TRU SWAT team was tasked to serve a "no knock" narcotic search warrant for the Bell County Task Force at 1104 Circle M Dr. Apt. C. The task force stated that the male suspect named in the warrant was Marvin Guy. My task was to rake and break the A6 window, which was the northwest window to 1104 Circle M Dr. Apartment #C. The SWAT team deployed on Old FM 440 and ran over to this location. I was on the window team, which was tacked onto the end of the entry team stack. The entry team made it to the front door and I ran over to the window. Detective Kirk was my lethal cover for the window, I was holding the rake and break tool (long solid tool, which requires both hands and is designed to penetrate glass to clear, blinds, curtains, etc. from window in order to view inside). The entry team arrived at the front door just before I was able to get to the window. Before striking the window with the tool, I overheard the team yelling "Killeen Police Search Warrant," at the same time I overheard the door being struck by the ram. I yelled loudly "Killeen Police Search Warrant," prior to striking the top portion of the window, just after approximately one hit of the ram striking the front door. Once I struck the top portion of the window, the glass broke and I was able to stick the tool deep enough inside the window to pull the blinds out with the hook of the tool. I pulled the tool out and Detective Kirk illuminated the inside of the room to quickly clear the room of any persons that may have been in the room, but I was unable to view inside because of my attempting to keep my back against the wall for cover. I then yelled, "Killeen Police Search Warrant" and quickly struck the bottom portion of the same which, at which time I heard a loud pop that I believed might have been the flash bang that was supposed to be deployed in the front door once entry was gained. As I pulling

the blinds from the bottom portion of the window to the outside with the tool, I heard rapid fire and observed muzzle flashes coming toward me in what appeared to be in an upward position. The room was dark, but I observed a silhouette of a person but could not make out if it was a man or a woman, but did notice the silhouette appeared to be big in size. The suspect was close enough the window that I could feel the pressure from the muzzle blast push against my vest. I immediately knew this to be gunfire; I dropped the tool and attempted to go for my police department issued pistol, which was in my thigh holster, at the same time I was attempting to get away from the window while yelling, "They're shooting." Approximately the fourth pop I felt what I believe was a bullet from the gun strike my tactical vest in the chest area, which knocked me backwards causing me to fall on my back and right side. The round knocked the window out of me so I could not communicate to my team as to where the rounds were coming from, but I observed team members firing rounds into the window. Once I fell backwards, I immediately began to roll to get to my feet and get out of the line of fire, so that I could engage the shooter to stop the threat. After I rolled, I overheard the distraction device go off. By the time, I came to my feet I attempted to engage the suspect in the room through the window, but I could not see the window due to the smoke from the distraction device. I looked over to my right and observed Officer McCown close to the window firing his rifle into the room; I began to walk backwards with my weapon pointed toward the direction of the window and fell over Officer Denton who was laying on the grass area just under the stairs to the same address. I got up, went over to the eastside of the building, and linked up with other SWAT members who were holding that position for cover. Once at this position, I observed Officer Denton firing into the window and yelling that he was hit and for our TAC medic to come get him. Officer Sune was close by Officer Denton, grabbed the back of his vest, and began to drag him backwards toward our position while we kept coverage on the window and front door. The TAC medic Neujahr came to the aid of Officer Sune and dragged Officer Denton to my location. I observed that Officer Denton had what appeared to be a gunshot wound in the left thigh area. Neujahr tore Officer Denton's pants and observed a hole in his leg that appeared to be actively bleeding. Neujahr placed a tourniquet on his upper thigh by his groin to stop the bleeding. While still holding coverage on the window and front door, I observed Officer McCown appear out of the smoke dragging Detective Dinwiddie. Detective Goodsby assisted with dragging Detective Dinwiddie to my location. Once at my location I observed that Detective Dinwiddie's eyes were closed and blood was covering his face. Neujahr and other SWAT members were stripping Dinwiddie's gear off him in an attempt to assess the severity of his injuries. Once the vest was off, I overheard someone say that Dinwiddie was not breathing and that he had a weak pulse, Officer Sune began chest compressions immediately and later switched out with Officer Jackson. By this time, the smoke was cleared and the firing had ceased. Once I knew that 100% coverage was contained on the residence, I stood up and began to check myself for any bleeding, in the chest area where I took a round. I did not observe any blood, but I felt pain on the right side of the chest and stiffness. Detective Daniels was standing next to me and I observed that he was looking down at his right hip area. Detective Daniels asked me to inspect him, because he was feeling pain in his right hip. I inspected Detective

Daniels and observed that a bullet hole was in the webbing of his thigh holster, but did not appear to have penetrated the skin; I also observed that Detective Daniels helmet had a dent in the very front of it directly in the middle of his forehead area. The pain was peeled and I observed Kevlar showing and appeared a little frayed. Detective Daniels and I inspected each other and found that we both were able to continue in order to finish the mission and get everybody detained inside the residence. Detective Wingfield was tending to Officer Denton as well and gave me his rifle, because he knew that I only had a pistol at the time. Detective Wingfield later assisted in lifting Officer Denton and went with him to the hospital. Almost immediately after the inspection, the team in the back stated that they had a male detained who later identified himself as Marvin Guy. Guy informed them that a female was still in the residence and she was the one that was shooting at Officers. Sometime later, the female came out of the front door of the residence in a nightgown and was detained. Officer Denton and Detective Dinwiddie were enroute to the hospital at this point at which time the team began to make plans on conducting a slow clear of the residence of any other person inside so that scene could be made safe and locked down for CID Detectives. The door team consisted of Detective Mirabel, Detective Daniels, Officer McCown, and I, while the rest of the team began breaking windows and visually clearing the residence from the outside. Once that was complete, the team made entry into the residence and cleared the entire residence. I cleared the room where the shots came from and observed several spent shell casings throughout the room the room still smelled like fresh gunpowder. The bed in the room did not have a frame. The box spring and mattress was on the floor closer to the wall by the window than in the middle of the room. I observed a black Taurus handgun lying beside the bed with the slide locked back, I knew this to be a Taurus because I could see the letters on the handgrip of the gun. I left the room and observed that in the living room behind a couch were silhouette's used at a gun range rolled up with holes in them. I left the residence and met with the team in the parking lot of the laundry mat across the street. Fire Chief Garner informed Detective Daniels and I that since we both struck by bullets, that he was instructing us to go to Scott & White by ambulance. Both Detective Daniels and I were transported to Scott & White Hospital and later released with minor injuries.

#### 112. **Written Witness Statement of Yvette Guadalupe**

- 5-10-14 – At about 5:13am on May 9<sup>th</sup> I was hearing "Police, Police." Then I started hearing boom, boom, boom. Then I went to my door and I could still hear "Police, Police." I looked out the window and I could see multi police and SV AT outside the street a couple apartment complexes down. Then I heard gunshots and I looked out my door. Officers were yelling out to me to get back into my house and I heard police telling my neighbor to get back into her house. When I first looked out the window I could see the police in helmets and gear that belongs to police officers. I later saw them dragging away the wounded police officer after the gunshots. After that a whole bunch of cops showed up with a fire truck even before the ambulance showed up. I knew it was cops when the whole thing started because I heard "Police, Police" clear and loud. This happened two apartment complexes down from mine. I heard from someone who is always with OG and people he talks to, the multiple people he visits on a daily

basis, one of them warned me to keep an eye out for my kids sake. Because they told me OG said "I'm ready for the Police and it's gonna go down." The person who told me this said OG is crazy like that because he already did 23 years in the pen.
