Thank you for contacting me. It is good to hear from you and I'm pleased to respond.

The input of my constituents is crucial to guiding me on how to best represent them in Congress. One of my most important duties is to listen to your concerns and find the best ways to address them.

As you may know, S. 3955, the Justice for Breonna Taylor Act, would prohibit law enforcement agencies from conducting no-knock warrants. Supporters of this bill argue that no-knock warrants, which permit law enforcement officers to enter a premises without first identifying their authority and purpose, infringe on the basic constitutional rights of American citizens and can lead to unnecessary confrontations between police officers and the public, as demonstrated in the tragic killing of Breonna Taylor.

S. 3955 has been introduced in the U.S. Senate where you are represented by Senators John Cornyn and Ted Cruz. You can be sure I will keep your views in mind should similar legislation be introduced in the U.S. House, where I am a member.
