Every member of the Conquerors program will be held to these standards of conduct. All players will be held accountable to these standards consistently by their teammates, coaching staff, and administration. Parents and coaches will be held accountable for both their personal conduct and the students/players under their leadership. Any violation of these standards will have repercussions, including possible dismissal from the team, temporarily or permanently.

		All members of the Conqueror program will show honor to God, families, coaches, referees, and teammates in actions and words as representatives of God, their families, and the Conquerors program.
		SVA is a Christian association with prayer at all events, practices, and games.
		Players and Parents will be supportive of other players/coaches, any concerns should be handled privately.
		Players should be pursuing academic success in all their classes, according to their parents' standards.
		Players are expected to be at all team events, games, and practices.
		Playing time is determined by each team's coach. If there is a question about playing time, the player should first bring it up with the coach. Then the parent should come with the player to discuss.
		The coaches will determine which players will play for each team. Coaches are responsible for monitoring and correcting the behavior of the players with the cooperation of the parents.
		No player should be allowed to participate who has turned 19 prior to August 1st, has passed the GED, or graduated high school. He/She should have a notice of intent to homeschool on file with the city/county.
		Upon Request, families must present a birth certificate and the letter received from their city/county school board showing their status as a homeschooled student.
		Players should dress in a conservative manner, befitting a Christian young man/woman, while at all SVA functions as a representative of Christ, our association, and the home-schooling community. After a warning, if it continues, the coach may remove the player.
		No use of profanity, crude gestures, or inappropriate behavior by players, parents, or fans at any SVA function will be tolerated and result in immediate suspension.
		Families will be willing to put forth every reasonable effort to participate in the fund-raising programs deemed necessary to insure proper maintenance of required equipment and facilities.
