## Instructions on sending your Ancestry DNA matches.

- 1. Log into Ancestry account
- 2. Click on your DNA tab and select DNA Summary
- 3. In the upper right hand corner there is a gear icon click there. It will bring you to your DNA settings.
- 4. Scroll down towards the end of the page until you get to the section that says share your ethnicity's and DNA matches.
- 5. Click there and that's where you will add the following email address to give us access to your matches:
