


Can God Trust You? - Part 1 (A)

It goes God's way, and it comes your own way too. Many people you see in the church today left the church at some point. but because of challenges they ran back to church. They ran back to God because they trust Him to do something for them. Someone said some time ago that trust is



the implied value of a relationship.

Let us see what the living God declared concerning Abraham in Genesis 18:17-19 when God came to destroy Sodom. "And the Lord said, "Shall I hide from Abraham what I am doing, since Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him? For I have known him, in order that he may command his children and his household after him, that they keep the way of the Lord, to do righteousness and justice, that the Lord may bring to Abraham what He has spoken to him ""

That is God's testimony concerning a man. A man who did not originally start with God. The

story of Abraham that we hear is that he was born into an idolatrous community. It is said that the place where he was born was full of idol worship. But when God called Abraham out and told him that He was going to show him a land and give it to him and his descendants, Abraham started a pattern of trusting God.

That, however, is not the totality of the story. There are two parts to it. Abraham trusted God in coming out of his father's land, and over the years, God also was able to trust Abraham. The scripture recorded that Abraham will be a great nation because God decided that it will be so, but Abraham also had to prove that he was trustworthy himself. The question is, "Can God trust you?"

It is true that when the chips are down, everyone will call upon one deity or the other. It may not be the God Who created the heavens and earth that some people call upon, but I ask, can the God who created you and saved you, trust you? Can God trust you?

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO TRUST?

- It means to have confidence in a person's integrity.
- 2 It means to have assurance in a person's truthfulness. Little wonder the book of Amos asked. "Can walk two together, unless thev agreed?" There must be a measure of trust between two people to be in a relationship. And for as many as are in a relationship with the living God, as your Father, can He trust you?
- 3. It means to have confidence in the healthy availability of a person in a relationship. Some people are in relationships but are not available. God was looking for a man to stand in the gap Ezekiel 22:30 but found none: "So I sought for a man among them who would make a wall, and stand in the gap before Me on behalf of the land, that I should not destroy it; but I found no one."

- He could not trust any that He found. As we go on with this teaching, you will see that there are some people in the Bible who presented themselves to God and started with God, but in the long run, God was not able to trust them. May you not be like that in the name of Jesus Christ
- 4. It means to have a strong belief in a person's reliability. What the Holy Spirit is asking you through this teaching is this: Can heaven rely on you despite all the things going on in the world, in your family, and in your life?

5. It means to be a certain person of honest dealings. Are your dealings honest as far as Heaven is concerned?

TYPES OF TRUST

Experts have identified the following types of trust:

- 1. Basic trust.
- 2. Competency Trust. I am very sure that a person who has a medical heart condition will not go to their banker to consult about their heart. There will be a competence problem there. If they do that, they have gone to the wrong person.
- 3. **Relationship Trust.** There must be a measure of trust in the people you call your friends or in the relationships that you have.
- 4. **Organizational Trust.** This is when you know that an institution will do what they have promised.
- 5. Identity Trust.
- 6. Confidence Trust.

- 7. Authentic Trust: There are so many areas of the world where they sell knockoffs now just to make some money at the expense of others. Even during the COVID-19 pandemic some people washed and re-sold masks that had already been used. You need to know how authentic these things are.
- 8. Fellowship Trust.

These are just eight of the various kinds of trust that exist. Can God trust you?

WHEN TRUST IS BROKEN

Let us see some passages in the scriptures where we meet some people that God could no longer trust. They started with God, and then God said, "I will no longer trust these people."

The Household of Eli

Let us meet the household of Eli in 1 Samuel 2:26-32. "And the child Samuel grew in stature, and in favor both with the Lord and men. Then a man of God came to Eli and said to him, "Thus says the Lord: 'Did I not clearly reveal Myself to the house of your father when they were in Egypt in Pharaoh's house? Did I not choose him out of all the tribes of Israel to be My priest, to offer upon My altar, to

burn incense, and to wear an ephod before Me? And did I not give to the house of your father all the offerings of the children of Israel made by fire?

Why do you kick at My sacrifice and My offering which I have commanded in My dwelling place, and honor your sons more than Me, to make yourselves fat with the best of all the offerings of Israel My people?' Therefore the Lord God of Israel says: 'I said indeed that your house and the house of your father would walk before Me forever.' But now the Lord says: 'Far be it from Me; for those who honor Me I will honor, and those who despise Me shall be lightly esteemed.

Behold, the days are coming that I will cut off your arm and the arm of your father's house, so that there will not be an old man in your house. And you will see an enemy in My dwelling place, despite all the good which God does for Israel. And there shall not be an old man in your house forever."

God established Eli's family. They started with God, and God gave them a particular position. He gave them responsibility over His people, His house, and the nation. But trust was broken, and God could no longer trust them. The child Samuel grew in favor with God, but the family of Eli had broken trust. Because they broke trust. God cut them off. Can God trust you?

The Lord will restore you if you have broken trust with Him. in the name of Jesus Christ

Ananias and Sapphira

In Acts 5:1-5, we read about a couple from another family. God requires trust. You trust Him; He should be able to trust you too.

Do you know why it is important that God is able to trust you? It is because He cannot carry out His work on earth without men

May you not fail God in the name of Jesus Christ.

"But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession. And he kept back part of the proceeds, his wife also being aware of it, and brought a certain part and laid it at the apostles' feet. But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and keep back part of the price of the land for yourself?

While it remained, was it not your own? And after it was sold, was it not in your own control? Why have you conceived this thing in vour heart? You have not lied to men but to God." Then Ananias. hearing these words, fell down and breathed his last. So great fear came upon all those who heard these things."

His wife did not fare any better. She also came in, and when Peter asked, "Did you sell the land for so much?" She said, "Yes." Some people have read that passage and asked, "Is God not too hard? Can I not do what I want with my money and with what belongs to me?"

God is not too hard. Ananias and Sapphira misrepresented the truth and were deceitful. Peter said, "When the land remained, was it not in your power? When you sold it, was it not your own? It is still yours. Nobody is hijacking anything." All they needed to do was say, "No, this is how much we want to give," but they falsely claimed the entire amount was the price of the land when they had held back part of it. They misrepresented the truth because they wanted people in the early church to respect them.

They were like termites in the early church that were ready to eat into the fabric of the church by misrepresenting the truth. The

truth was, "Yes, we sold it for so much, but this is how much we want to give the church." And that would have been okay. But they did not do that. God could not trust them with the unrighteous mammon. Can God trust you?

Do you know why it is important that God should be able to trust you? It is because God cannot carry out His assignment and His work on earth without men. He wants men who are trustworthy, who will not pollute His work, who will not malign His work, who will not bring His work to disrepute. May heaven find you trustworthy, in the name of Jesus Christ. If you have broken trust at any time, may heaven restore you, in the name of Jesus Christ.

WHAT CAN GOD TRUST YOU WITH?

 Can God trust you with your afflictions? A lot of people say, "Yes, God can trust me with billions. I will solve all the problems of this world." But sorry, that is not the way it works in God's economy. Before you get to solving the problems of the world, can God trust you with afflictions?

In Psalm 34, the Bible talks about the afflictions of the righteous. A lot of people want freedom from affliction. They say. "Oh. this affliction must pass. I reject affliction, in the name of Jesus Christ." Psalm 34:18-20 savs. "The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, And saves such as have a contrite spirit. Many are the afflictions of the righteous, But the Lord delivers him out of them all. He quards all his bones; Not one of them is broken."

Can God trust you in affliction so that you allow the affliction to do what it needs to do in your life so that God can be glorified? Nobody wants affliction. But we see the righteous afflicted in this passage. Can any evil thing without God's happen permission? No. Can you be afflicted as a child of God without God knowing about it? No.

The affliction of Jesus Christ brought us deliverance. Isaiah chapter 53:1-5 says, "Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed? For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, There is no beauty that we should desire Him. He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him: He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed."

Jesus was afflicted by God. This was His beloved Son. Did Jesus suffer because of any sin that He committed? He was clean and free from sin, but still He was afflicted God allowed affliction to come to Him All the affliction that came upon Jesus Christ was for us. It was not for Him. But God could trust Him even when the affliction was on Him. Can God trust you?

Some people say, "I wonder why this is happening to me." If you really want to grow in God, you should ask, "God, is this of You?" If He says, "Yes," then rejoice.

Jesus Christ was afflicted, but not for Himself. If He had said. "No more. Affliction, I reject you. I do not want you," what would He have been saying? He would have been telling the purpose of God to take the back seat, and we would not have been saved. We would not have delivered. We would not have

Sickness received peace. would have continued to ravage our lives.

Are you afflicted because of righteousness or are you afflicted because of your sin? These are two different things. Jesus Christ was in right standing with God. His affliction came because He was in right standing with God, and God could trust Him through His affliction. If you do something wrong and you afflicted. bear punishment. But in this case, God allowed this affliction. He allowed the wounding of Jesus Christ

Isaiah 53:5 says, "But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was

bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed." God trusted Him Through it all. Can God trust vou in vour affliction?


