Receiving Divine Prescription – Part 2

Make what heaven focuses on your focus, and heaven will bless you. The focus of heaven is the pleasure of the Ruler who sits on the throne

We looked at the first part of this topic last month where we defined a prescription as a knowledgeable solution given to silence a problem.

We learnt that Jesus Christ is the answer to all of life's problems and that the knowledge of God gives us knowledge of ourselves, knowledge of our enemy the devil, knowledge of the world

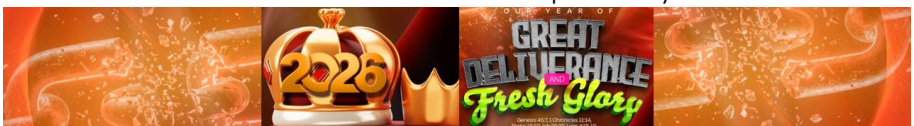
that we live in, and knowledge of God's kingdom.

John 10:19 says, *“And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven.”* We started looking at the Keys of the Kingdom of Heaven and considered the first three keys, which were the Principles of the Kingdom of Heaven, the Precepts of the Kingdom of Heaven, and the Laws of the Kingdom of Heaven.

We will now continue from key number 4.

KEYS OF THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN

4. **The System of the Kingdom of Heaven.** Heaven operates on a specific system—a series of



"operations" that trigger divine provision:

- **Worship:** Entering His presence with a heart of thanksgiving. Psalm 100:4 says, ***“Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, And into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name.”***
- **Devotion:** Being devoted to the living God. Psalm 62:12 says, ***“Also to You, O Lord, belongs mercy; For You render to each one according to his work.”***
- **Thanksgiving:** An appreciative heart is the system of heaven.

We rejoice, not because of circumstances, but based on the character of our Father

- **Prayers:** In Luke 11:2, Jesus Christ taught us to pray. ***“He said to them, “When you pray, say: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven...”*** That is the system of heaven. Aligning our will with the Father’s will. When your will deviates from Heaven’s, you obstruct the flow of divine provision. If your will is not the will of heaven, then the blessing of the One who is in heaven will not come. Such a person will not enjoy the liberty and provision that heaven promises.
- **Rejoicing:** We rejoice, not because of circumstances, but based on the character of our Father. Why should you rejoice? Rejoice because you have a Father

who has your back. Rejoice because you have a Father who loves you so much that He will not abandon you to your ways. Rejoice because you have a Father Who is the light that scatters darkness. Rejoice because your Father holds tomorrow. You do not need to bother about tomorrow because He has told you not to worry about what to eat or what to wear. He said sufficient for the day is the evil thereof. Just enjoy your God and rejoice in His glory and love.

5. **The Conduct of the Kingdom of Heaven.** As members of the King's family, our behaviour must reflect our lineage.

Micah 6:8: *“He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the Lord require of you But to do*

justly, To love mercy, And to walk humbly with your God?”

Matthew 23:23a: *“Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithes of mint and anise and cummin, and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faith.”*

Essential conduct of the kingdom of heaven includes:

- **Submission** to God's authority. James 4:7a says, *“Therefore submit to God.”*
- **Mercy, Justice, and Humility:** As summarized in Micah 6:8, these are the "weightier matters" often neglected by the religious yet prioritized by God (Matthew 23:23).
- **Faith, Discipline, and purposeful hard work:**

Consistent, purposeful hard work is expected; laziness is not a trait of the Kingdom.

- **Faithfulness.**

The pharisees neglected these things, so they did not enjoy the best of the King of the Kingdom of Heaven. They were sick. A hypocritical person is sick. They do not showcase the image and likeness of God in which they were created.

6. **The Focus of the Kingdom of Heaven.** Many believers suffer because they have shifted their focus from the King's pleasure to their own needs. The focus of heaven is the pleasure of the King of the Kingdom Himself.

Revelation 4:8-11 describes the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders saying, *"The four living*

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creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!" Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever, the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying: "You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created.""

Make what heaven focuses on your focus, and heaven will bless you. The focus of heaven is the pleasure of the Ruler who sits on the throne. The God who created everything you see and cannot see by His word. Celebrate Him.

7. **The Characteristics of the Kingdom of Heaven.** This is different from conduct. A distinction must be made between "being a good person" and having the "character of God." One can perform charitable deeds while harbouring a toxic internal state—a condition that does not pass the test of heaven.

That was the state that Cain got himself into. Cain brought an offering, just like Abel did, because it was a required offering, but Cain's person was not accepted. Abel was accepted because

his character matched the character of God. What Abel gave was approved because he himself was approved. But the sacrifice of Cain, whose character did not match the character of God, was rejected.

A lot of people do good and can even give their own lives and everything they have to the poor, but for as long as they lack these characteristics of heaven, all they do will be a waste.

What are the characteristics of the kingdom of heaven?

- **Love:** 1 John 4:7-8 says, *"Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. He who does not love does not know God, for God is love."*

The devil cannot overrun anything God is interested in. The power of the devil is subject to the higher power of the living God

You need to take this prescription seriously. If you do not love, then you do not belong to God, and you cannot enjoy the blessings of God. Look at what 1 Corinthians 13:1 says, *“Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal.”* Making noise with no impact.

Verse 2, *“And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains,*

but have not love, I am nothing.”

This prescription is for everyone who is created in the image of God and has accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, and for everyone who calls God Father. Verse 3 says, *“And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing.”*

Those who will reign with God and benefit of His glory must have love.

- **Righteousness.** Practice what is right, just as God is righteous. 1 John 3:7 says, *“Little children, let no one deceive you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous.”*

- **Power.** Many people love this characteristic and chase power at all costs, but anyone who gains power without righteousness and love gains that power from the devil. Psalm 62:11 says, *“God has spoken once, Twice I have heard this: That power belongs to God.”*

Power belongs to God. That is a characteristic of heaven. That is why the devil cannot overrun anything God is interested in. The power of the devil is subject to the higher power of the living God. The devil cannot touch anyone who takes this prescription seriously and applies themselves to it. The enemy may stand against you and oppose you, but they will never prevail.

- **Truth.** God speaks the truth all the time. You will never see God change or say He was joking about what He said to you. So, you need to speak the truth always because you are created in His image and likeness, and you want to carry His glory, power, and represent Him. You must speak the truth in your heart and with your tongue. If you are in a compromising situation where you are pressured to lie, you had better hold your peace.

REASONS WE NEED DIVINE PRESCRIPTION

We need divine prescription because there are so many things that contend against us. Let us look at some of them:

1. **Satanic offenses and invasions.**

2. **Selfishness:** The passion to celebrate yourself and put God aside.
3. **Confusion.**
4. **All kinds of fear.**
5. **Anxiety about what tomorrow will hold:** There are also people who are afraid of what is in their past.
6. **Poverty.** This includes poverty of spirit, poverty of soul, poverty of ideas, poverty of relationships, financial poverty, and all kinds of poverty.
7. **Doubt.** When you begin to second-guess your creation and why God created you.
8. **Competitiveness.** This is the mindset of "I am better than you" or "somebody cannot be better than me." I heard

the story of a company driver who was assigned to a man in Nigeria for his official vehicle. When driving, this driver did not like having any vehicle ahead of him; he had to overtake them. Whether it was reasonable, on a bend, or on a hill, he had to overtake. Even if it was a sixteen-wheeler, an eighteen-wheeler, a tanker truck going at a snail's pace, or a motorbike, he would say he did not like anything in front of him and wanted to see the road clear. He was always overtaking.

Some people are like that in their lives. They believe nobody can do things better than them. They feel they must be the only ones recognized in a place. They believe their voice must be the first and the last. If people do not listen to them, they will leave the group. Competitiveness prevents

the image of God within us from showing.

pandemic, many more people would have died.

9. **Ingratitude.** This generation is one of the least appreciative of all generations. There is a sense of entitlement. People feel they are entitled to things, so they wonder why they should say thank you. You even see it in homes now. Children do not say thank you to their parents, even for cooking food. When they are told to do the dishes, they ask why they alone should do it, though they eat and sleep without working.

This is also creeping into the church. Things are done for people, and they simply say the person is just doing their job. Even for those doing their jobs, we should still thank God. If the many frontline workers were not there during the COVID-19

13. **Laziness.** A lot of people want something for nothing. They want to live in the best house on the street, but they are not willing to work hard.

14. **Unforgiveness.** This is preventing many believers from showcasing the glory of God.

Beloved, you have received these divine prescriptions. Go over them and integrate them into your life. The blessings of God that the devil cannot take away will locate you as you use these prescriptions in the name of Jesus Christ. As you take them to heart, you will see that all God's promises for you will find fulfilment. You will not need to tell the enemy that you are the

head and not the tail; the enemy will know that you are the head when you take these prescriptions.

The question is: Will you honour God by living to please Him? Will you give God pleasure with your lives?
