#### **CHURCH RELAUNCH**

#### **General Guidelines**



- 1. Those to wait till next phase before in-person attendance is considered:
  - Age 65+
  - Age 14 & below (no Children Church for now)
  - Those with underlying medical conditions
- 2. No physical group meetings, etc. would be permitted after church services.
- 3. Vigil services would remain online / at-home for now,
- 4. Attendees will be requested to fill out registration data forms (Name, Address, Phone No., Email Address) for each service before entering sanctuary.
  - Each household or cohort can complete one registration form for all members
- 5. Those prohibited by law from attending church services:
  - i. Travelled internationally in the last 14 days (or have visitors who travelled internationally)
  - ii. Had close contact with confirmed COVID-19 cases in the last 14 days
  - iii. Had close contact with COVID-19 cases awaiting results in the last 14 days
    - Symptoms to look out for cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat, pinkeye in children
    - Please use the online the Alberta Health Services COVID-19 Self-Assessment tool before every church visit. ## **Movement in Church Building**

- 6. Signage and floor "physical distancing" and "one way" decals are in place to direct movement.
- 7. Entry and exit doors designated for church building and sanctuary.
- 8. There will be controlled exit from church auditorium and building after service (e.g. by seating section).
- 9. Families and cohorts that come to church together should leave the church together.

## **Physical Distancing & Safety:**

- 10. Seats in sanctuary would be rearranged to reduce number of seats to ensure 2 meter distancing rule.
- 11. Congregants should avoid sitting together unless they are from the same household or cohort family.
- 12. Wearing of non-medical face masks is compulsory for church attendance while maintaining 2 meter distance from anyone who is not a household member.
- 13. Shaking hands, hugging, touching, or passing items should not occur. Except between members of the same household or cohort family.
- 14. Attendees should always follow proper respiratory etiquette. This includes coughing and sneezing into the elbow or a tissue, discarding tissues into a lined garbage bin, and washing hands afterwards.
- 15. Hand sanitizers would be provided at church entrances and exits, and throughout the church.

# **Church Services:**

- 16. Services would conducted with maximum attendance limits based on seating arrangement in main sanctuary and physical distancing guidelines.
- 17. Physical attendance would be on a first come-first served basis when sanctuary is full:
  - This would be immediately announced by the officiating minister and posted in WhatsApp platforms
  - Members who came afterwards would be politely turned back (either to return home or worship from their cars)
- 18. Seeing the pastorate would be strictly by appointment for now. Waiting room would be locked-up.
