## The Night Cometh

When the time has come for you to pursue your heavenly assignment, and you do not take it seriously, know for sure that time will not wait for you and it may expire

Let us look at these undying words of Jesus in John 9:4, ***“I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.”*** It is good for us to also look at Ephesians 5:15-16 before we go on, ***“See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil.”*** Circumspectly is a big word for being careful, being cautious and being guarded.

To redeem the time is to use your little time here on earth as best as possible. That your time is a special commodity God has given to you. Your years on earth here are a probationary period to prove to the Lord that you are ready for the next world. It is a blessed opportunity for you to prove that you love the Lord.

When the time has come for you to pursue your destiny, when the time has come for you to get into God’s assignment for your life, when the time has come for you to pursue the reason for which you were born, when the time has come for you to move into the realm that God wants you to move into, when the time has come for you to pursue your divine agenda, but you do not take it seriously and you refuse to utilize all the opportunities you

have, let it be known to you that time is nobody's friend.

Time is going. The poem they taught us in primary school says, "Tick says the clock, tick, tick. What you have to do, do quick." The clock is not a friend or enemy of anybody. 5 p.m. today is gone now and it is gone forever. Even if you turn your own clock back to 5 o'clock, other clocks will not read 5 o'clock.

When the time has come for your divine assignment and God has given you opportunity for it and you do not take it serious, know that time is going and very soon that time may expire and therefore you will not be able to fulfil it again.

Maybe you suddenly woke up one day and you discovered you had wasted your time, and you now want to rush back to do the things you ought to have done ten years ago, five years ago or twenty years ago; the people prepared by God to prepare you at that time you ought to have done it must have moved on. They cannot train you again. You cannot have the opportunity again. Any work they even try to do for you at that time is expired work. It is gone.

Any goal you score after they have blown the final whistle in a football match is a wasted effort. Know that time is going. It is not a friend of anyone. This is a very serious situation.

I remember when the Mountain of Fire started, I was telling some of our pastors, "Be serious *now*, be serious *now*..." At that time, the General Overseer would gather a few of them and teach them. Sometimes we would teach for fourteen hours non-stop. "Take this serious, take this serious..." Some did, while some

did not. Many of those who did not take it serious are back now, but the General Overseer who used to sit down at a round table talk and talk to them for fourteen hours is no longer available to do so. He has moved on. Even if I tried to do it now, it would be expired work. A work you are supposed to have over-grown.

Sometimes the night comes on somebody because they are no longer active like they used to be. You discover that you cannot do the dry fast you used to do in those days again because that time is gone.

Sometimes the night comes in form of a marriage. When you were not married, God was saying, “Be serious, be serious...” You were not serious then. Now you have married a man who is

opposing Christian activities, who says, “If I see you in church, I will kill you.” Night has come.

Sometimes the night comes in form of old age. To every man that night will come, when you can do no work. You must work the works now.

Sometimes the night comes because of sickness, which prevents the person from now doing what they could do before.

Sometimes a person who has been strong before finds out they are no longer as strong as they used to be. We have seen people who used to do dry fasts before, now they try it and they faint.

Sometimes the night comes because there is a school God put

you in to preach the gospel. God sent you to the university so that you can preach the gospel and convert lives, but all your time there, you spent it clubbing away and following strange people. Now you have left that campus where you were supposed to minister, you are out of it, night has come.

Sometimes night comes on a person because they are forced to migrate from their place of assignment. Migration from country to country is not sometimes due to the economy. It may be due to war. Many people have had to migrate to some other places. Maybe you were placed in a corner in Nigeria, there God gave you the opportunity to minister and impact lives. Then something happened and you migrated to a country where you now had to start learning the language. The night has come.

The night can sometimes come due to persecution. There is freedom to preach the gospel now. The opportunity may close.

Death is the final and inevitable exit for all of us from the world we are in today. This means that the night is coming upon every man who is born to this earth

The night may come as a result of imprisonment. Do not deceive yourself that all those who are in prison are offenders, there are people who are there who did nothing, people just put them in trouble.

The night cometh when a person is dead. Finished. Death is a contract that man has signed and there is no escape. Many people hate death but there is nothing they can do about it. Nobody, no matter how high or how low you are, can overcome it. Once death comes, everything comes to a standstill. Death is the final and inevitable exit for all of us from the world we are in today. This means that the night is coming upon every man who is born to this earth.

This is a serious situation. They may sing after the person's coffin that he has gone to heaven. No, he has gone straight to hell fire because he did not fulfil his purpose. His coming here was the coming of a sugar daddy who wasted lives and who is now going to be wasted in hell fire instead. Like I have said before, if nobody is learning anything good from you, then you have come to waste your time on earth. This is a serious situation.

The night comes when the day of opportunity has passed. ***"I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work."*** God's best gift to us is not in material things. His best gift to us is opportunities. What Blind Bartimaeus had that day was an

opportunity, and he grabbed it. What the woman with the issue of blood had was an opportunity, and she grabbed it.

My heart goes out to thousands of MFM members and thousands of our pastors who do not know where they are. They do not realize that God bringing them to Mountain of Fire and Miracles Ministries is an opportunity. Listen and listen to me well, God does not use a person who has had a chance and will not take it. He gave you opportunity and you disgraced the opportunity. You squandered it. You wasted it.

When you dismiss an opportunity, you miss success. That is why successful people are always children of opportunities. Sometimes what we call adversity, God calls opportunities. Small opportunities are often the beginning of great achievements. Many of what you call obstacles are opportunities in disguise. The mystery of opportunity is this: great opportunities come to those who make the most of the

small ones they get. This is a serious matter.

Once the opportunity is gone, that is it. The night has come. If you read your Bible well, there are many men and women in the Bible who wasted opportunities. They never recovered it.

Adam and Eve had the opportunity in the garden to live forever, not to be hungry, not to do all kinds of things that are troubling us now, not to have malaria, sicknesses, hepatitis, HIV... those things were not in the garden. They were microbes that God gave Adam dominion over. The animals in the Garden of Eden did not kill human beings. They played around. They talked

to themselves. Adam and Eve wasted the opportunity.

Cain was even advised by God saying, "Why are you angry? If you have done something wrong, correct it." He lost the opportunity.

Lot moved with Abraham. His movement with Abraham was an opportunity. Abraham was his uncle. Everywhere Abraham went, he erected an altar. So it is easy for you to track down the journeys of Abraham in the Bible by looking at the altars that he built. Lot never raised any altar. He did not learn anything from moving with that man. He wasted the opportunity.

The men of Sodom and Gomorrah saw angels coming out with men. They wasted the opportunity. Esau that was given a birth right wasted that opportunity. The sons of Eli who were supposed to be priests. They wasted the opportunity.

Saul was supposed to be king and his family kings forever. He

wasted the opportunity. Just as Lot never took advantage of his relationship with Abraham, Gehazi did not take advantage of the opportunity of being with Elisha. The person they call the prodigal son in the Bible, was a story of wasted opportunity.

So God could put you in a good church, with a good pastor who teaches the word of God and who teaches prayers, and you take everything for granted. You waste that opportunity. You need to see where God has positioned you and make the most of it.

Over the years I have watched many young pastors move out of position. Sometimes I ask them, "What is wrong with being an Assistant Pastor?" "What is wrong with being a Branch Pastor?" "What is wrong with being a Zonal Pastor?" They waste the opportunity God gave to them.

Are you positioned by God in this church? You better sit well in your chair. There are many people standing by to replace you. I

always tell people, it is better to be the leg of a lion than to be the head of a cockroach. Many have wasted their opportunities. That is why the Bible says, **"...redeeming the time, because the days are evil."** You must redeem your time because the days we are living in are evil.

The days are so bad. Indeed, the way the world is now, it is like all of us are inside a deep freezer. If you find yourself in a deep freezer, you will quickly freeze to death if you sit down. When you know you are in a deep freezer, you have to start jumping up, stretching your legs and moving about. That is what this world needs now. If you sit down you will freeze to death. There is only one thing to do if you are inside

that freezer: you keep walking, you keep moving and you keep jumping until somebody gets you out of the freezer.

We have been left in a huge freezer of this world and we must do everything to remain alive. Unfortunately, some are settling down to relax in this dangerous worldly freezing environment. Surely beloved, the days are evil. You must redeem the time.

You must redeem the time because it is the will of God that you do so. If you do not do so, you will get into trouble. You must redeem the time because that is the wisest thing to do in this world now.

You must redeem the time because the Bible says in Job 14:1, ***“Man that is born of a woman is of few days...”*** Our days here are few. Therefore you must redeem the time. You cannot waste your time.

You must redeem the time because your life here is like a fixed contract. There is an

appointed time to men on earth. Time is fixed for each person. Some have thirty years, some have forty years, some have fifty years, some have sixty years. Every day you spend gets you closer to that date when the contract of that life would be over for you. So, indeed life here is short. You must start redeeming your time.

You redeem the time by making the most of the opportunities God has given to you. You redeem the time by waiting on the Lord more. You redeem the time by ministering to people more and by witnessing more.

You redeem the time by praying as much as you can pray. You redeem the time by fighting and winning as many battles as possible. You redeem your time by preaching and getting souls saved as much as possible. You redeem your time by praying more and more.

You redeem the time by sharing tracts to people and evangelising people. You redeem the time by

attending as many prayer meetings and Bible studies as possible. You redeem the time by making sure that your quiet time is stable.

You redeem the time by working for as many hours as possible for the Lord. To redeem the time means you give as much offering as you can while you are here. You redeem your time by supporting as many things God is doing as possible. God's projects.

You redeem the time by helping the poor as much as you can help. You redeem the time by praising God for as much as you can praise God. You redeem your time by volunteering your skills to help the Master in any area you can.

You redeem the time by overcoming as many temptations that would face you as possible. ***"...redeeming the time, because the days are evil."***

I will go right back to where I started from. When the time has come for you to pursue your heavenly assignment, when the

time set has come for you to begin to fulfil your divine mandate, when the time has come for you to plug your life into God's socket for your destiny, and you do not take it seriously, you are not grabbing that opportunity, know for sure that time will not wait for you and it may expire. The night would then have arrived when you cannot do anything.

It is a tragedy for a man or a woman to get to heaven and cry bitterly, although you are supposed to be happy, when you see what you should have done but did not do. When you see the great opportunities God has given to you and you have wasted them. God sent you as a lady secretary to that office because he wanted you to be a light to convert the Managing Director. How can you convert him now when you are sleeping with him? You were given that opportunity and you wasted it.
