We read from Proverbs 24:16, ***“For a just man falleth seven times, and riseth up again: But the wicked shall fall into mischief.”*** A knockdown is not a knockout. There is a large school that a lot of human beings enroll in. The purpose of this message is to

cause the deliverance of God to happen to all those who are in that school. It is called the School of Quitters.

The quitter is a father with the following seven children:

1. Procrastination
2. Fear
3. Indecision
4. Compromise
5. Lack of Vision
6. Discouragement
7. Incomplete or Lack of Deliverance

Those who enroll in the University of Quitters have at least one credit in these seven



subjects. These are the seven demons that always want to make people quit, give up, kill themselves, and destroy their own lives.

The husband of a woman ran away. He was stolen by her best friend. She was very unhappy. Her blood pressure went up, she could not eat, she could not sleep, and she was so sad. Then at night, she heard a voice saying, “Can you see yourself? You only have one child so there is no problem yet. You can go and marry somebody else now that this man has been stolen by your friend. Look, that is

poison in your cupboard. Give it to the child. Kill this child to free yourself. Then you can start your life from scratch.” But She said, “No, I will not do it.” And the voice kept saying, “Do it. Do it. Do it...”

At that point, she started to call on the blood of Jesus repeatedly. As she was calling on the blood of Jesus, the doorbell rang in the middle of the night. She wondered who it was, and she opened the door to find her husband prostrating on the floor. He started saying that he was sorry, it was the enemy that caused it, and that it would not happen again. See what the enemy wanted to do to her. There are people whom the enemy just wants to terminate before their glory appears.

Was it that God did not know that Adam was hiding? He knew that he was hiding. So, the question "Where art thou?" is heavily pregnant and is still a very solid question today.

God is asking you, "Where are you on your destiny map? Where are you regarding your vision? Where are you regarding the plan of God for your life? Where are you regarding the gifts that God gave to you? Where are you regarding the talents that God gave to you? Where are you regarding the opportunities that God gave to you? Where are you regarding the call of God for your life?" He is asking you

those questions and if you cannot answer them, then the enemy that wants you to quit will chase after you severely. God does not quit. So, His true children do not quit.

It is true that the school of quitters has a large number of students. The majority quit, but successful people remain who will not quit. The truth is that for any success or good opportunity you have, the demon that wants to make you quit will be close by. made them, and try to change who God has made them. All the gifts and talents God has given to you are deposited into your personal account and you determine what to do with it. There are souls attached to that talent and gift you have. So, you must not fail, and you must not plan to fail. Some people start their journeys at junctions where others are trying to give up.

At this point, there are some solid questions I need to ask you. What exactly is your vision for your life? Are you planning to die small or are you planning to die big? Do you believe God for anything really big? Would there be a revival in this church if everybody in the church were at your level of spirituality? Ask yourself, “Am I a time waster? Do I have diarrhea of the mouth? Always talking

and talking? Do I harbor unforgiveness? Do I practice any destructive habit? What gifts and talents do I have? Do I give up easily? Am I creative? Do I harbor envy and jealousy? Am I teachable? Is heaven happy with me? Am I happy with myself?” These are questions you should ask yourself.

What do you do first thing in the morning? What do you do last thing at night? This is essential. Do you start your day with prayer and end your day with prayer? Your first moments in the morning and last moments at night are your most vulnerable spiritual

periods. Procrastination is a killer. It is a tool of the devil to make you miss the best of your life. Worry is another killer. Worry leads from somewhere to nowhere. Fear also causes a lot of trouble.

Humans are bound to experience failure and make mistakes. People fail at some point in their lives. It is always better to fail at something than to do nothing at all. When you are knocked down, you must decide to get up again. Falling down is not failure. Remaining down is the failure. Many important people have had a time when they were down, but they rose again, and they were able to fulfill the purpose of God for their lives. God can use you right where you are today. God can use you as a vessel. God can do wonders in your life. God can move you from the dunghill to the

throne. God can turn you from zero to hero.

There was a music competition that had a lot of money attached to it. This was outside Nigeria. This brother went to compete and he lost in the first round, and they had to go through three rounds. The finals were to involve seven people, but they added three of those who had lost in the opening rounds just to make up the number to ten. This brother, who was very sad and had already given up, was called to be one of those three. He then did something that changed the story of his life.

He went on a dry fast and prayed prayers from the book Prayer Rain. Then he went to this competition. What happened after that was strangely awesome. By the end of the competition, this man, who lost in the first round, was the one who ended up winning. Something that had never happened before.

There are people in Scripture we can consider. They had their own faults, they fell, but they rose again. They did not remain down there. If they had remained down there, we would not be reading about them today. What God

hates is when you make sin a habit. You know what you are doing, and you are intentionally doing it. If a believer falls into sin, it should be by mistake. But you will be disciplined for any sin that you pre-plan or ask forgiveness for before you commit. There is no forgiveness for that. You will be disciplined for it. You may think it would not be used against you on the day of Judgment, but you will suffer the consequences because you had been warned and you still planned it.

If, however, you do something in ignorance, the Bible says that God winks at the times of ignorance. He then calls you to repentance. God does not want anyone to be a habitual sinner. But if by mistake or by your own error the enemy knocks you down,

you should not allow that knockdown to be a knockout.

Abraham was a nomadic man but, eventually, he rose and became the father of many nations despite his imperfections. Jacob, who was once a deceiver, eventually became the father of the twelve tribes of Israel and his name was changed to Israel. Joseph went down and became a prisoner. He was knocked down, but he refused to stay there. He became Prime Minister. Moses was a stammerer. When God called him, he gave eleven excuses for why

he did not want to go for the assignment. Yet he became a deliverer.

Deborah was a housewife, but God brought her up and she became a judge. David was a shepherd boy, but God took him, and he became a king. Esther was an orphan. God took her and she became a queen. Isaiah, the man with unclean lips, God took him and he became the messianic prophet. Shadrack, Meshach, and Abednego were slaves from the land of Israel. God took them and promoted them to leaders in the nation of Babylon. Paul was a persecutor of Christians who became the greatest missionary in history and the author of two-thirds of our New Testament.

David was a shepherd boy, but God took him, and he became a king. Esther was an orphan. God took her and she became a queen

At this point, there are some solid questions I need to ask you. What exactly is your vision for your life?

All this is telling you is that a knockdown is not a knockout and every enemy that wants you to stay down there is an enemy you should confront. I want you to know in your spirit that you are on a spiritual military operation to go into the camp of the enemy and silence all your silencers. For those who are calling your name day and night saying, “You must fail, you must fail...” it is you who will tell them that their words are backfiring. And they would backfire.

You need to make God your friend. It is compulsory. You need to repent from every

known sin. You need to cry to the heavens against those powers that have conspired together to make sure that you fail in your journey.
