Stop Obeying Your Fear – Part 2

We all come into situations that make us afraid but we need to look unto God and we need to disobey our fear

Last month we started to look at the introduction to this topic. We also looked at the definition of fear and the evil effects of fear. We continue from where we stopped.

How do you provoke a change for the best in your situation?

Every one of us has situations that make us afraid. Yours may be different from your neighbour's. We all come into situations that make us afraid

but we need to look unto God and we need to disobey our fear.

1. **Know and accept the truth that God is the only one who writes the program of your life.** Never debate this and do not allow the devil to cast doubt on this. Psalm 139:13-16 says, ***“For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well. My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, and curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. Thine eyes did***

see my substance, yet being imperfect; and in thy book all my members were written, which in continuance were fashioned, when as yet there was none of them.

This means the days of my life had been fashioned by God, even when I was not yet born. Verse 17-18 says, ***“How precious also are thy thoughts unto me, O God! how great is the sum of them! If I should count them, they are more in number than the sand: when I awake, I am still with thee.”*** What a wonderful rendition of the purpose of God for your life. Say out loud: “God has

written the program of my life. I shall not fail because God is not a failure.” You need to know it and accept it. God is aware of whatsoever may come your way and those things will not rewrite your history if you do not obey your fear. They will not rewrite the story of your life. They may attempt it but they will not succeed. It is not the devil that made you and fashioned you. It is not the devil that wrote the program of your life. Stop obeying your fear. If the devil attempts to re-write your life’s program, God will frustrate and destroy him. That is what He did to Pharaoh and Herod.

- 2. Stop worrying about what the enemy says like Goliath and how they pursue you like Pharaoh and his army.** The enemy has a deeply cruel heart and there is nothing good that can come

out of the mouth of the devil concerning you. Nothing good can come from the inside the belly of darkness for you, so do not pay them any mind or pay any attention to them. Stop worrying about them because the more you worry, the more you will obey your fear. See what the enemy says In Exodus 15:9, ***“The enemy said, I will pursue, I will overtake, I will divide the spoil; my lust shall be satisfied upon them; I will draw my sword, my hand shall destroy them.”*** The living God says you should not be afraid. Isaiah 41:10 says, ***“Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.”***

There is a story about a man who did not love his Christian

neighbour. They had their houses close beside each other. The neighbour who did not love the Christian would wake up early in the morning, before every other person, turn to the house of his Christian neighbour and begin to curse him. It was the cursing that woke the Christian up every morning. When the Christian woke up, he would have his devotion and then go outside, after the cursing man had stopped, lift his hands to Heaven, say a prayer of blessing for his cursing neighbour and go about his day. This happened every day for years. After about 5 years, the cursing man woke up one day and found that he could not move any part of his body or get

up from his bed. He could, however, talk to his wife and was awake. They packaged him off to the hospital where they checked and said everything seemed okay, but he still could not move by himself. So they packaged him back home again and for the first day in years, there was no cursing from him. The blessing man, however, went on blessing. After three weeks the cursing man still could not get out of his bed. He would eat and, if he was not attended to on time, would defecate in the same place. He became a burden to the family. The blessing man continued raising his hands every day to bless. When the wife of the cursing man had enough, she told her husband that she needed to call their Christian neighbour to come and pray for him but he refused and replied his wife with curses. So he continued in his situation for another two weeks and the problem worsened. He could now no longer defecate and

could not sleep because the discomfort. The wife said again, "Are you still insisting that this man should not come to our house?" He then conceded and asked her to call him. So they invited the Christian man for the very first time into their home. The man came in and said, "I learned that you were sick and I have been praying for you that you would get better. Do you want to accept Jesus Christ into your life before I pray now? He is the only one that can answer your prayer." The wife replied, "We will accept." Then the wife, the man and the children confessed Jesus Christ, though the man did it grudgingly. The moment he did, the Christian man lifted his hands and said, "Father I thank you that you

have shown my neighbour that you are God forevermore. Father remove all the resultant curses that he has been heaping from his life because of the blood of Jesus Christ” Before the Christian man could get out of the house, the man that could not move had a huge bowel movement and then he could move freely.

The enemy may be talking and raising accusations. The enemy may say, “I will pursue, overtake and plunder them and be satisfied on them...” but do not be worried about what they say because He that is with you is greater than He that is in the world. Do not worry because the more you worry about what the enemy is saying or has said,

the more you will continue to obey your fear. The enemy may imagine evil but the God who is on your side is strong and powerful.

- 3. Turn to God in your troubles and inquire of Him what you should do.** When you act in fear, you will not do what God wants you to do. David at different times in his life had serious problems but he always inquired of the Lord what he must do. We see in 1 Samuel 30:7-8, ***“And David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, I pray thee, bring me hither the ephod. And Abiathar brought thither the ephod to David. And David enquired at the Lord, saying, Shall I pursue after this troop? shall I overtake them? And he answered him, Pursue: for thou shalt surely overtake them, and without fail recover all.”*** In verses 18-19, ***“And David***

recovered all that the Amalekites had carried away: and David rescued his two wives. And there was nothing lacking to them, neither small nor great, neither sons nor daughters, neither spoil, nor any thing that they had taken to them: David recovered all.” He pursued them, overtook them and recovered all. Turn to God when the accusation of the enemy is overwhelming. When the pursuit of the enemy seems to have overrun you, turn to God. Inquire of the Lord what you should do.

4. **Drop all your spiritual excess luggage that is impacting your faith Journey.** Hebrews 12:1 says, *“Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us”*
5. **Focus on righteous living** because righteousness exalts a nation. A righteous person will observe to do the commandments of God. A righteous person will not return to sit with the scornful nor go in the way of sinners. A righteous person may make mistakes, but the moment they recover themselves, they turn back to God.
6. **Trust in the Lord with all your heart.** Trust says: “I am sold out to God. I am not

going to go anywhere else.” When everybody was leaving Jesus Christ, He turned to the twelve and asked them if they would also go away. Peter asked Him, “To whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.” Trust the Lord with all your heart.

7. Be faithful unto God. 2

Chronicles 16: 9 says, ***“For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him. Herein thou hast done foolishly: therefore from henceforth thou shalt have wars.”*** Proverbs 28:20 also says, ***“A faithful man shall abound with blessings: but he that maketh haste to be rich shall not be innocent.”*** And in Luke 16:10-11, ***“He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust***

in the least is unjust also in much. If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches?”

There are some biblical characters who stopped obeying their fears and God dealt with their mountain problems.

1. **Abraham** became the Father of Faith when he disobeyed his fear. God said of him, “Now I know that you fear me” and all his mountain problems were resolved.

2. **Isaac** had his own issues too.
3. **Jacob** had so many things he suffered. He suffered 14 years to marry the woman he loved. It was a mountain problem.

Now God is called the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob because they disobeyed their fears at some point in their troubles.

4. **Moses** had his own mountain problems. He was a vagabond from Egypt. He disobeyed his own fear too because he thought Pharaoh would kill him. He disobeyed his fear and went to Pharaoh.
5. **Joseph** also had his own mountain problem. He had a prophetic dream but his brethren did not believe in it and his parents doubted him. His brothers sold him into slavery in a strange

land, but because he disobeyed his own fear, trusted in the living God and walked in righteousness, God promoted him.

6. **Noah** also disobeyed his own fear. Rain had never previously fallen before he started building the ark. It was said that he built that ark for 120 years. He disobeyed his own fear and the pressure from his community. He was doing something that was unheard of and when the rain came, he had the last laugh.
7. **Ruth** also disobeyed her own fear. The future looked bleak but she believed she

could not just leave her mother-in-law Naomi alone. Naomi had nobody. Her husband and her two sons were dead and they were the only hope that she had. Ruth had no hope of even having another husband, talk less of having a child, but she did, because she disobeyed her fear. Her fear could have pushed her to go back to her own people. She went where the odds were against her because she disobeyed her own fear.

8. **Paul the Apostle** disobeyed his own fear too.
9. **Naaman** the Syrian had his own fear, misgivings and

anger, but when he was prevailed upon, he went and dipped himself in River Jordan seven times and came back clean. Disobey your own fear.

10. **The woman with the issue of blood** did not know how her energy would carry her through the crowd around Jesus, but she pushed through, hoping to just touch the hem of His garment. She disobeyed her fear and she was made whole.

Stop obeying your fear and start trusting the Lord.
