Create a Better Future – Part 1

God created everything to honour His name. If anyone truly believes the living God, he can also create a wonderful future for himself in the will of God by his faith

If there is anything that the church of Jesus Christ should be celebrating, it is Easter. You should celebrate it in a way that you know. Not according to the rituals that have been put into it, but to connect back to what Easter actually means in the heart of God for His people.

If Jesus Christ at the time he was born did not go through the expectation of the Father, did not submit Himself and

surrender Himself to die, if he struggled and got out of that arrangement like He was tempted to do in the Garden of Gethsemane, then we would not have justification. But by His death, He created a glorious future for those who truly believe in him. Our God is the God of all creation and the Bible says in Luke 1:37, ***“For with God nothing shall be impossible.”***

In Mark 9:23, ***“If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes.”*** Jesus Christ clearly informed the father of the boy suffering from epileptic seizure that all things are possible to him who believes. God created everything to honour His name and for His own glory. Therefore, if anyone truly

believes the living God, he can also create a wonderful future for himself in the will of God by his faith.

Please go with me to the book of Ruth 1:1-17 ***“Now it came to pass, in the days when the judges ruled, that there was a famine in the land. And a certain man of Bethlehem, Judah, went to dwell in the country of Moab, he and his wife and his two sons. The name of the man was Elimelech, the name of his wife was Naomi, and the names of his two sons were Mahlon and Chilion—Ephrathites of Bethlehem, Judah. And they went to the country of Moab and remained there.***

“For wherever you go, I will go; And wherever you lodge, I will lodge; Your people shall be my people, And your God, my God.”

Then Elimelech, Naomi’s husband, died; and she was left, and her two sons. Now they took wives of the women of Moab: the name of the one was Orpah, and the name of the other Ruth. And they dwelt there about ten years. Then both Mahlon and Chilion also died; so the woman survived her two sons and her husband.

Then she arose with her daughters-in-law that she might return from the country of Moab, for she had heard in the country of Moab that the Lord had visited His people by giving them bread. Therefore she went out from the place where she was, and her two daughters-in-law with her; and they went on the way to return to the land of Judah. And Naomi said to her two daughters-in-law, “Go, return each to her mother’s house. The Lord deal kindly with you, as you have dealt with the dead and with me. The Lord grant

that you may find rest, each in the house of her husband.” So she kissed them, and they lifted up their voices and wept.

And they said to her, “Surely we will return with you to your people.” But Naomi said, “Turn back, my daughters; why will you go with me? Are there still sons in my womb, that they may be your husbands? Turn back, my daughters, go—for I am too old to have a husband. If I should say I have hope, if I should have a husband tonight and should also bear sons, would you wait for them till they were grown? Would you restrain yourselves from having husbands? No, my daughters; for it grieves me very much for your sakes that the hand of the Lord has gone out against me!”

Then they lifted up their voices and wept again; and Orpah kissed her mother-in-law, but Ruth clung to her. And she said, “Look, your sister-in-law has gone back to her people and to

her gods; return after your sister-in-law.”

But by the following statement and attitude of Ruth in response to her mother-in-law’s charge, Ruth created a better future for herself. Verse 16 reads, ***“But Ruth said: “Entreat me not to leave you, Or to turn back from following after you; For wherever you go, I will go; And wherever you lodge, I will lodge; Your people shall be my people, And your God, my God. Where you die, I will die, And there will I be buried. The Lord do so to me, and more also, If anything but death parts you and me.”***

It is not possible for you to continue to do the same thing the same way you used to do it and then you expect that you will get a better result

Ruth did not have any portion with the God of Israel until she married into Elimelech's family. Ruth was from the land of Moab and they did not serve the living God as the Israelites do. However, Ruth saw a better future with her widowed and childless mother-in-law, Naomi, and her people, than with the Moabites.

Every opportunity that the living God gives to you is for you to create a better future with Him. Every call of the living God is for you to create a better future. But for you to create that future, there must be a change. It is not possible for you to continue to do the same thing the same way you used to do it and then you expect that you will get a better result. Our General Overseer, Dr. D. K. Olukoya, has a thought on change. He said, "You cannot remain what you are and then become what you need to be." There must be a change.

Naomi came back to Bethlehem after a horrific experience in Moab and she refused to be called Naomi but Marah, for she said in Ruth 1:20, "***The Almighty has dealt very bitterly with me.***" Ruth having this understanding of the pain of her mother-in-law chose to stick with Naomi because she could see a better future. Ruth ended up marrying Boaz at the recommendation and urging of Naomi her mother-in-law and she gave birth to Obed.

Ruth 4:13-17 reads, "***So Boaz took Ruth and she became his wife; and when he went in to her, the Lord gave her conception, and she bore a son. Then the women said to Naomi, "Blessed be the Lord, who has***

not left you this day without a close relative; and may his name be famous in Israel! And may he be to you a restorer of life and a nourisher of your old age; for your daughter-in-law, who loves you, who is better to you than seven sons, has borne him.” Then Naomi took the child and laid him on her bosom, and became a nurse to him. Also the neighbor women gave him a name, saying, “There is a son born to Naomi.” And they called his name Obed. He is the father of Jesse, the father of David.”

Ruth got a better future for herself in the lineage of our Lord Jesus Christ by her decision.

WORDS IN THE BIBLE THAT OFFER YOU AN OPPORTUNITY FOR A BETTER FUTURE.

Every time you hear these words, you need to know that God is offering you a better future, but you need to change for that future to come.

1. One such word is when you hear ‘repent’. Anytime you hear ‘repent’, you know that God is offering you a better future. If you hold onto the way you do your things and you refuse to repent where God wants you to repent, the better future will not be there.

Look at Acts 3:17-19. This was Peter speaking with those people that came around because of the miracle that took place at the gate called Beautiful. ***“Yet now, brethren, I know that you did it in ignorance, as did also your rulers. But those things which God foretold by the mouth of all His prophets, that the Christ would suffer, He has thus fulfilled. Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord”***

A lot of people do not know that anytime you see 'repent', or God calls you to repentance, He is offering you an opportunity to create a better future. He has a better future in mind because He says in Jeremiah 29:11 (KJV), ***"For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end."*** The expected end in the mind of God is a better situation. It is a better circumstance than what you are going through now. So anytime you hear 'repent', it is God offering you a better future.

2. Anytime you hear 'forgive' and the living God says, "In a situation like this, forgive," do not hold on to your own way. Jesus Christ said when he was teaching the Lord's Prayer in Luke 11:4, ***"...forgive us our sins, For***

we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us." So if you do not want your own sin to be forgiven, all you need to do is just say, "I will not forgive." That is all. So a better future will not be there.

3. Another one is 'be merciful'. Matthew 5:7 says, ***"Blessed are the merciful, For they shall obtain mercy."*** Anytime you have the opportunity to make a judgement call on another person and you show mercy, you are creating a better future. Anyone that does not give mercy cannot obtain mercy.

4. When the living God tells you, "Don't call to mind the evil of the past." Isaiah 43:18a says, ***"Do not remember the former things."*** If you keep remembering what somebody did wrong to you in the past, and you begin to

plot revenge, you will always mess up your present life and the future will not be bright. I do not know what previously happened between King Ahab and Prophet Micaiah in 1 Kings 22. We were not told. But Prophet Micaiah was invited at the insistence of King Jehoshaphat after 400 prophets had prophesied to King Ahab concerning the battle at Ramoth-Gilead that he should go and he would win. But Jehoshaphat requested for another prophet to which King Ahab said, "There is one, but he will never speak good of me." If King Ahab had forgotten whatsoever happened between him and Prophet Micaiah in the past, he would have remained alive. But he did not.

Isaiah 43:18-19 says, ***"Do not remember the former things, Nor consider the things of old. Behold, I will***

do a new thing, Now it shall spring forth; Shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness And rivers in the desert." Anyone that would not remember the evil of yesterday will have a better future. Anyone who, like in James 1:19, is ***"swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath;"*** will create a better future.

5. When you are encouraged by the scriptures to obey God, it is an opportunity for you to create a better future. Deuteronomy 28:1 says, ***"Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all His commandments which I command you today, that the Lord your God will set you high above all nations of the earth."***

Abraham was called out of his father's land. He did not know where he was going

but he obeyed God. A lot of people start obeying God at the beginning of their journey in life, but when the going gets tough, they stop obeying God. Just like Abraham did, he stopped obeying God and he slipped into sin where he produced Ishmael.

If you think that because you obey God at accepting Jesus Christ now, He would just leave you to run your life by yourself in the way you deem fit, it will bring you into vanity. But as long as you continue to obey God, your future will be brighter.

6. Anytime in the scriptures, you hear the living God say, "Be holy for I am holy..." He is calling you to create a better future. Daniel was taken from his land into a strange land as a slave. When they got there they offered him a lot of things and he said, "No, I will not

defile myself with the king's portion." This is because he was conscious of the holiness of God within him. He said, "I will not defile it." And God helped him such that, instead of living and dying as a slave, he ruled and died in a land that he was brought as a slave into. This was because he created his own future.

We have a lot of examples in the scriptures. Yes, it was true the living God gave Joseph a dream. A destiny dream. But if Joseph did not cooperate with God, his future would not have been better. Create a better future.

7. When you hear God call you to pray. This is because a lot of wonderful and glorious things happen in prayer. Destinies are also transformed in the place of prayer. Just as Jabez had his

destiny transformed by God when he prayed.

Let us see what happened in 1 Samuel 1:1-8, ***“Now there was a certain man of Ramathaim Zophim, of the mountains of Ephraim, and his name was Elkanah the son of Jeroham, the son of Elihu, the son of Tohu, the son of Zuph, an Ephraimite. And he had two wives: the name of one was Hannah, and the name of the other Peninnah. Peninnah had children, but Hannah had no children. This man went up from his city yearly to worship and sacrifice to the Lord of hosts in Shiloh. Also the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, the priests of the Lord, were there. And whenever the time came for Elkanah to make an offering, he would give portions to Peninnah his wife and to all her sons and daughters.***

But to Hannah he would give a double portion, for he loved Hannah, although the Lord had closed her womb. And her rival also provoked her severely, to make her miserable, because the Lord had closed her womb. So it was, year by year, when she went up to the house of the Lord, that she provoked her; therefore she wept and did not eat. Then Elkanah her husband said to her, “Hannah, why do you weep? Why do you not eat? And why is your heart grieved? Am I not better to you than ten sons?” Hannah did not respond. I am very sure if it were to be some women of today, they will respond or they will react.

Look at what Hannah did in verses 9-10, ***“So Hannah arose after they had finished eating and drinking in Shiloh. Now Eli the priest was sitting on the seat by the doorpost of the***

tabernacle of the Lord. And she was in bitterness of soul, and prayed to the Lord and wept in anguish.” Every opportunity you have to pray about your situation is an opportunity to create a better future, because the prayer of faith will receive answer.
